- A signed-in conference administrator can send emails through bikebike.org with the "Contact Users" function, but emails sent this way are often delivered days later, if at all, due to an issue with the way bikebike.org sends email. Instead, consider sending mass emails with...

Buttondown.email

This is a mass emailing service like MailChimp or constant contact. Contact Angel or Darin for the password. In case of emergency, anyone with access to bikebikeeverywhere@gmail.com should be able to reset the password - but please inform everyone else who has access to it if you do so (see the "who has access to what" spreadsheet stored in google drive)!

- Write emails with the visual editor or in Markdown
- You can select who gets emails with the tag selector at the bottom:



Sending to all subscribers

- As of May 2022 there are tags for languages, "Orgs" (organizations, rather than individual people), and Bike!Bike! Everywhere! 2021 Attendees.
- Click the Bike!Bike! logo in the top right to add people to the list, access settings, etc.
- Bike!Bike! got a pro account donated, so we have some bonus features that aren't included in the free versions. (The only pro feature we really use is it means our emails come from @bikebike.org. Not worth ever paying for, but nice to have since it's free.)
