to No ICE in Marin Coalition

It is appalling that the Marin County Sheriff's Office continues to cooperate with ICE, even though California is a sanctuary state and our community has made it abundantly clear that we reject these harmful practices. As ICE and DHS escalate their cruel, lawless attacks on immigrant families and peaceful protestors across the country, I believe we must do everything in our power to end collaboration between our sheriff and federal immigration authorities. Our neighbors' safety, dignity, and humanity depend on it.

As Mayor of Tiburon, I have worked proactively to make sure our local police department does not cooperate with ICE's cruel agenda, and I support No on Ice's work to get the Marin County Sheriff to stop its cooperation with ICE. I am wholeheartedly with No ICE in Marin and stand ready to assist you as your next state assemblymember. As a SURJ graduate and elected official with a 30 year progressive history in the civil rights movement, I will always stand with No on Ice.

I support the toughest legislation in the country currently before the CA legislature to not only ban ICE agents from wearing masks to hide their identities, but to allow Californians to civilly sue ICE agents when they deny people their civil rights. The Marin County Sheriff's Office must refuse all ICE requests, stop publishing booking logs and instead adopt a searchable system like those used in San Francisco, San Mateo, and Santa Cruz counties, and fully and permanently withdraw from the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP).
