Former State Director Joe Sachman hopped on the call and shared his experiences running for office and speaking to legislators as a Wolf-PAC volunteer.

We talked about contacting dormant volunteers, keeping an eye on the State Legislature website, particularly with regards to the legislative calendar, the Caucus Chairs, and the legislators' voting histories. If they have voted to pass an Article V resolution on our topic or any other topic (eg: balanced budget) that's a good sign that they're okay with Article V. However, some legislators have been known to say they're "unsure of how risky" an Article V convention might be when talking with us, so it's super important to know how they've voted for any BBA or other resolution, because you can't have it both ways. We talked about what an amendment might look like and stressed that Wolf-PAC doesn't get to say what the amendment is, only the delegates to the convention will decide on how the amendment will be worded. What we're asking for is a call for the convention. Also, Congress may step up to propose an amendment if enough states pass our resolution (which is usually what happens). Good call.
