Creative Process	Watch	Do
Inspiration	What is a Zentangle?	Check out these examples of Zentangle artwork. In your story, copy the links to 3 or more ideas that you would like to incorporate into your artwork.
Design	Develop Your Craft	Use a page in your sketchbook to practice 5-7 Zentangle designs, including the 3 you found as inspiration. Take a photo and add it to your story.
Creation	Create your composition	Very lightly, sketch in your strings. Think about having a variety of shapes to fill. Make sure that you have at least 7 spaces to fill with designs. Take a photo and add it to your story.
	Design Details	Using a pen or marker for lines and pencils for shading, create your own Zentangle, with interesting and complex designs. Sign your work. Take a photo and add it to your story.
