Old Business:

Financial Report:

2023-2024 school year PTO began w/a surplus approx. \$1800 and projected for 2024-2025 we project \$3100. QR Code for PTO Donations by Parents/Guardians will be available for the Back to School Bash in late July.

Freshman Orientation:

7/23/24 at NHS. Parent Meeting will be from 5-6pm in the Auditorium. PTO will have a table set up w/QR Code and Volunteer Sign up. McKenzie will briefly speak to the Parents in Auditorium about what the PTO has done over the past two school years and how parents can get involved. Need runner for morning donuts and lunch for the Teachers (Jenny Sochocki will do if off SR 37 otherwise find 1-2 parent volunteers. McKenzie will create a Google Form for volunteers to sign up.

New Business:

Vote at Meeting in July for new Officers: Vice President, Treasurer, & Secretary. McKenzie will stay in the President role for 2024-2025 School Year.

Student Services: In 2023-2024, PTO donated \$250 for snacks 2nd semester, which lasted 2.5 months, we ordered through Amazon. We will vote in July to increase that amount, if needed, so the PTO can help for the entire 2024-2025 school year.

Back to School Bash, 7/26/24 from 5-8pm on NHS Football Field; McKenzie, Adam, & Jenny will be present. Ideas for our table: two large give away baskets will be drawn from raffle tickets; a raffle ticket will be given to each person that donates towards the PTO (cash or QR code). Each basket will have \$150 worth of Noblesville Merch in it. Call Laurie Dyer and Shelly Nobbe for merch ideas. Does NHS have an extra tent for PTO on that day? Raffle ticket (Jenny has them) will be filled out by donator, they get one side we get the other, they do not need to be present to “win” the basket. We also will put together two other prizes (gift card to Miller Mall and all sports pass). Look into a 6ft NHS PTO Banner we can purchase and use every year going forward (call Laurie Dyer).

Bag to School Bags for Teachers: Include some needed items for Teachers (sticky notes, dry erase markers, lottery scratch off tickets, etc.). McKenzie will contact Staples, Walmart, Meijer's, etc. to see if they'd be willing to donate any items.
