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Behavioural Observation:

Amber Rose arrived at the interview earlier than expected, he was dressed informally in a hoodie and jeans, and his hygiene and posture were standard, Amber Rose was focused however he tended to break eye contact on several occasions. Arabic is his first language however it is evident that his English is proficient, he spoke with a normal tone but at a fast pace but traces of lisping were observed.
