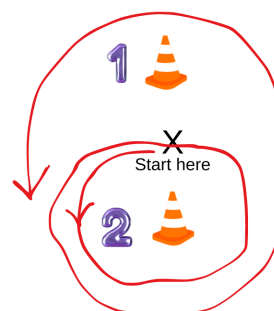


Test A1. Walk and Trot. On the Line

	Movement	Feedback	Score
1	Start in halt at X. Send the horse on to a small circle in walk left around you and cone 2	Super! Responsive transition and lovely circle	10
2	At X, ask horse to trot	Tiny wee bit late to trot cost you the 10. Otherwise super	9
3	Trot a small circle left around you and cone 2 finishing at X	Lovely. Keep working on that inside flexion :-)	9
4	From X, trot onto a circle left which will go around cone 1	Good job. When the bend improves this will become a bit less sausagey and a bit more circular	9
5	After a full circle trot towards X and halt at X.	Good job for where you are now. When you get a stop from a distance, you will be able to stay still in the middle of the circle and get some juicy marks :-)	7
6	Back up 4 steps	Lovely purposeful steps	10
7	Swap onto horse's other side and send horse on to a small circle in walk right around you and cone 1.	Good effort. When the inside bend improves, the focus will improve too :-)	8
8	At X, ask horse to trot.	Ooops a little muddle to trot but nice recovery.	8
9	Trot a small circle right around you and cone 1 finishing at X	A little tense on the circle but held it together :-)	8
10	From X, trot onto a circle right which will go around cone 1	Better shaped circle but keep working on the bend	8
11	After a full circle trot towards X and halt at X.	Good effort. When the transition is direct from trot to halt you will	6

		get higher marks	
12	Ask horse to wait whilst you walk a circle around your horse. Return to him and praise him.	Super baby in the pouring rain!!	10
	Degree of difficulty	You will get higher marks here when the transitions are more direct and you can build distance with the stop and back up... but you're doing great	7
	Connection and harmony	There were moments when he looked a bit tense but he quickly relaxed again. This will only get better as his bend improves. Well done	8
