This document serves to ensure that all patrol vehicles are equipped to an acceptable standard for patrol duties.

Chapter 2.00.0 - Policy Information

2.01.0 Performance Modifications

1. Patrol Vehicles may have the following Modifications:
 - a. EMS Brakes Level 5
 - b. EMS Transmission Level 5
 - c. EMS Engine Level 5
 - d. Turbo (Taurus/Explorer(s) Only)
2. No other performance modifications beyond the Extras list may be applied to patrol vehicles, unless stated otherwise by Administration or if active as a subdivision that explicitly allowed other kinds of modifications.

2.02.0 Appearance Modifications

1. Patrol vehicles may have **White Xenon** as the headlight colour.
2. No other appearance modifications beyond the Extras list may be applied to Patrol vehicles, unless stated otherwise by Administration or if active as a subdivision that explicitly allows other kinds of modifications.
3. Vehicle license plates must state "SAST####", for example SAST0001 or SAST0159. The Troopers UID signifies your issued vehicle fleet number.
4. Unmarked vehicles will have the plate "GV####SA" GV for Government Vehicle, and the SA for San Andreas, these need to be on Yellow and Black Plates. Example GV0001SA or GV0159SA

2.03.0 Vehicle Equipment

1. All patrol vehicles shall be equipped with the proper equipment as seen in the **table below**. Officers must abide by the equipment listed below and should not use the quantity shown.
2. No other equipment shall be used unless it meets one of the following requirements: (1) it is a legal requirement for all vehicles (e.g. spare tire, fire extinguisher, etc.); (2) it's clearly visible (e.g. cage, gun rack); (3) it's trifling (e.g. clipboard, water bottle, umbrella); (4) it has been approved by a Supervisor+ (e.g. tent); (5) or if active as a subdivision that explicitly allows other equipment.

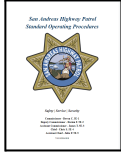
