5 mins	Set up video to watch. Students sit on floor.	Term 2 - Lesson 18 video
5 mins	Introduction:	Provided above
	Introduce the topic: Weather	
	Today we will learn Auslan signs for Weather.	
	Brainstorm some Weather signs that we might learn (e.g. rain, sunny, hot, windy).	
	"Ensure that your hands are ready to sign, your eyes watching the lesson, and what else? Yes, voices off."	
	 (start of lesson) Read and discuss the Learning Intention and Success Criteria. Check for understanding, clarifying vocabulary as necessary. 	
10 mins	Explicit Teaching: Watch the video	Term 2 - Lesson 18 video
	Use teacher discretion to decide if the class needs to watch any part of the video a second time. Signs taught: weather, rain, wind, snow, wet, warm, cold, hot, storm, sun, lightning, thunder, clouds, dry, hail.	
5 mins	Explanation of activity:	
	 Students and teacher will draw a picture of a particular 'weather' (e.g. a rainy day, windy day, cold day, very hot day, cloudy sky etc) Students will bring the drawings back to the floor/whole group to share. Encourage each student to sign one Weather sign about their drawing. Practise the Weather poem. 	

15mins	Activity: Drawings about Weather Whole group 'Share Time' Practice the Weather poem	Sign Reference Sheet Lesson 8 video (poem section)
5 mins	 Practise the Weather poem Reflection with students: (select from the following) Did you enjoy the Weather Poem? Which part was the best? Which weather signs look like what they are? e.g. cloud, lightning, sun, others? (for teacher: iconicity) Choose a sign to describe the weather today.
