Interested in Auto Body Repair and/or Automotive Technology? Check out these colleges below.

## **Remember these 4 Things:**

- 1. Community colleges have "**open admissions**", this means they do not have any GPA/SAT requirements. You just have to apply and send your transcripts. You will usually receive an admissions email within a week of applying.
- 2. The Community College Guarantee through the state of Michigan. This makes community college **FREE** for Michigan residents who graduate from a Michigan high school in 2023 or later.
- 3. If you want hands-on classes only, choose a certificate program. If you don't mind taking 3-5 general education classes (english, math, science, social studies) and want a degree, choose an associates degree program.
- 4. Check with your Counselor or College Adviser to see if you qualify for the <u>Tuition</u> <u>Incentive Program (TIP)</u>. More than 60% of WMHS seniors do. This will allow you to earn a certificate <u>AND</u> an associates degree from Michigan community colleges and universities (that have associate degree programs) or a couple of certificates.

This guide also lists colleges that have on-campus housing/dorms and an automotive related program.

**A.A.S** stands for Associate of Applied Science. Example: AAS in Automotive Technology. This means you will receive an associates degree after completing the program.

**Cert** stands for Certificate of Achievement or Vocation Certificate. Example: Certificate in Automotive Technology. This means you will receive a certificate of achievement after completing the program.
