

The Difference Between the First Heaven and First Earth and the New Heaven and New Earth

Main References: Rv 21, Rv 6-7, Jer 31:22, Rv 3:12, Rv 19, Rv 20:1-6

God created the heavens and the earth and all its creation; He created Adam and gave all creation to him to rule over.

At this time, another god (spirit) who betrayed, appeared in God's Garden of Eden (Ref. Gn 2:9, Ez 28). That is why God commanded Adam, "You must not eat of the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat of it you will surely die." This word was the law concerning death and life. Adam believed in the serpent's words and so broke the law of God and ate the fruit of the knowledge of good and evil. Then he died and returned to dust.

At the time of the fulfillment of Revelation, the former world of God's creation, the heavens and the earth and all its creation, came to an end and a new heaven and new earth was created. And so, He showed that the first heaven and first earth will disappear and a new heaven and new earth will appear (Jer 31:22, Rv 6, Rv 21). This work is the work of Revelation and re-creation. However, the former world doesn't just disappear nor does the latter world just appear. It all happens through the process of events from Rv 1 to Rv 22.

What kind of events are they? The former world must come to an end (like in Rv 6) for the latter world to exist, right? Inside the former world, there is the god (spirit) who betrayed, the rebellious people, and the corrupt creation. Only by fighting and overcoming could the former world be brought to an end. And that is why there was war, and it had to be fought and won (Rv 2-3). This war was a fight against the betrayers, the destroyers, and their gods (spirits). The spirit of God and His family were needed to fight and overcome. This number was 144,000. This is an event in the physical world.

Satan's army has two hundred million mounted troops (Rv 9) and there is God's army of white horses (Rv 19). They are fighting over one thing, and that is this world. God's victory in this war created the new heaven and new earth. The acronym of this new heaven and new earth is Shincheonji (新天地). Shincheonji was created for the first time in the 6,000 years since the creation of the former world.

This article (writing) is trying to tell you the difference between the former world and the latter world. The 6,000 years of the former world was controlled by the dragon, the devil, and it was a world where death existed. The latter world is a world where death has disappeared by capturing the devil (dragon) in the war and locking him up in the Abyss (Rv 20:2-3, Rv 21:4). It's a world of eternal life that God reigns over. At this time, the spirit and flesh marry by the holy spirits of heaven coming down to mankind; and man becomes a god-like man. Also, all creation is healed and made anew (Rv 21:5). With this, mankind and even vegetation live a long life.

This is the difference between the former world and the latter world. Would Jesus, who had even raised the dead to life, leave the living to die? The kingdom of eternal life is opening. However, according to Paul's testimony in 1Cor 15, this change takes place in order at the time of the Lord's second coming.

This is the true life of faith and the objective God desired to fulfill. God's promise and Jesus' blood don't come to an end in vain, but fulfill their purpose. Jesus' victorious blood of life enters each person to resolve every sin. They become God's children born again of God's seed to become entities of His image and likeness. And they live in God's kingdom of heaven where there is no sin, and there is no dragon, forever. This word will be fulfilled to those who believe. Amen.
