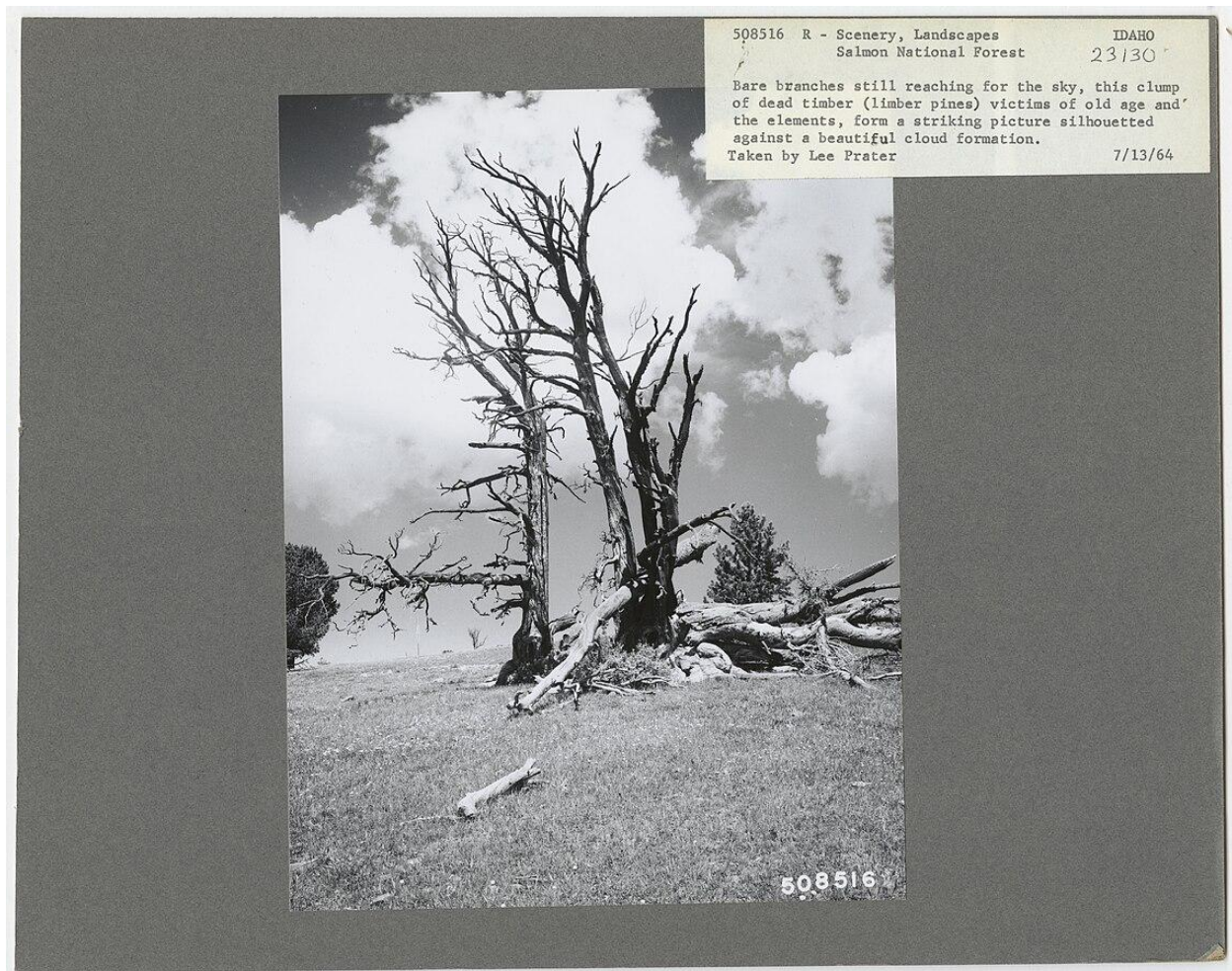


Sourcing, Source F: "Tree Branches"
