Course Description

Spanish II is a continuation of Spanish and focuses more deeply on the four key areas of foreign language study: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The course will solidify their foundation to succeed in advanced language classes at the high school or college level.

Course Objectives

Students will be able to express themselves using a variety of verb tenses coupled with pertinent vocabulary. Grammatical structures will more closely resemble natural speaking.

Materials and Access

- Students will have their Chromebooks every day, charged and ready to be used in class.
- Announcements, lectures, homework descriptions, warm-ups, etc. will be posted to Classroom.
- All graded activities will be posted on my website and must be submitted there for credit.

Homework Policy

- Homework will be assigned on a regular basis. Your responsibility is to complete the homework on my website and be ready to participate when going over the homework in class.
- Homework will be assigned in class and posted on my website. All homework must be submitted by 7:00 a.m. the next day. No late homework or make-up homework will be accepted.
- Answers to the homework will be displayed in class as we go over the activities. It is your responsibility to make corrections and resubmit your homework after we have checked it.

Absence Policy

- If you are absent from class for any reason, you will be responsible for what you missed.
- Announcements, lectures, homework descriptions, warm-ups, etc. will be posted to Classroom.

Bathroom Policy

- Use the bathroom on your way to class.
- You may take a pass during class, provided we are not in the middle of an in-class activity.

Quiz Policy

- Online quizzes will be given on the last day of the week, covering the material from that week.
- Students who miss the online quiz will take it during the next week at my convenience. You may have to take it on the first day of the week, so be prepared. You may take a paper version.
- If you only miss the day before a quiz, you will still take the quiz. We didn't learn new material.

Semester Exams

- The semester exam will be online and will cover all material taught for that particular semester.
- Any student who meets the exemption criteria will not be required to take the semester exam.

Grammar units: Various verb tenses, commands, possessive adjectives and pronouns, adjective use, adverbs, comparatives and superlatives, and reflexive, direct object, and indirect object pronouns

Culture units: Mexican Independence Day, Day of the Dead, Christmas in Latin America, Easter in Latin America, Cinco de Mayo
