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OVERVIEW & INSTRUCTIONS

This document is meant to **guide you in the writing of a Community Impact Project article to submit to J-TICH**. It contains **formatting requirements** for your entire article. Each section that must be present in your article is described and formatting requirements unique to a section are also stated.

Remember that this is a template you can use to pull your article together but is not what you submit to J-TICH. To make this document editable, go to File > Download or File > Make a Copy and use that version. When you are ready to submit, take the content from the boxes in this template, paste them into a Word document, and use the [APA Style Guide](#) to ensure that your submission is formatted accurately and grammatically correct.

PURPOSE of a COMMUNITY IMPACT ARTICLE

To discuss one or a cluster of recently published papers on a current research topic of high interest in which an author's perspective sheds an incisive light on key findings in research.
