**Dear Parents and Carers,**

If I were to reflect on previous years, I would definitely say that the children have usually enjoyed more September playtimes on the field than they have this year. It has certainly been a wet one! Sometimes the weather can make it harder to leave the house or lead to more cars on the road, but it is worth remembering that safety is always a priority when getting to school.

Attendance follows these thoughts as only yesterday, we shared the annual attendance letter. The aim of this approach is to continue the raised awareness that children have a better chance to achieve their best if they attend school regularly. This is a uniform strategy across all of the Dorset schools.

A few absences can quickly add up to a significant loss in learning time. For example, a child who ends the year with 95% attendance has been absent from school for the equivalent of 10 full days. Look out for the shared Learning First Alliance (Joint Statement), which is aimed to bring further consistency across our local schools. This will be shared soon.

As a school, we are committed to ensuring the highest possible attendance level for every child, and we have a very good overall track record. We are realistic in our view that some are sometimes ill, and/or require medical help. This is out of all of everyone's control, but I please ask for your continued support.

Having a consistent approach enables the schools to work together to spot patterns and reflect on ways to support and 'work with you' as families. We have increased our communications on attendance, and the impact that this has had on the figures is impressive. Below, you can see a poster that is often shared by schools. It does provide some examples of how the council could use the penalty notice more frequently. Please do come and speak to me, if you wish to discuss anything further.

Thank you for your shared understanding and let's continue to strive to keep children in school as much as possible, and on time.
