- ✓ US Citizen Between Ages 17 and 23
- ✓ NON U.S Citizens can apply with proper naturalization documents
- ✓ High School Senior, Junior in your second semester of high school or college student with less than 30 college credit hours.
- ✓ Minimum ACT Scores: Math 21 & English 22 AND composite of 28
- ✓ Minimum SAT Scores: Math 540 & Verbal 550 AND
combined 1300
- ✓ 85 (AFQT) Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB)
