

Dear Lindbergh Parents and Guardians,

*Parents, students, and staff are encouraged to use our [When To Keep Your Child Home document](#), which covers symptoms of COVID and other communicable diseases found in schools. We remind parents that children should always be fever free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medicine before coming to school. Adults and students also should not attend if they have vomited in the last 24 hours. *

Our school hours are from 9:00 AM-3:55 PM. Our ENTRY bell will ring at 8:55 AM. The TARDY bell will ring at 9:00 AM. Dismissal for all half days is 12:05 PM.

Late Starts: On late start days, school will begin 1 hour later with the entry bell ringing at 9:55 AM and the tardy bell at 10:00 AM

Attendance:

It is important to call the school every time your child is going to be absent, tardy, or needs an early dismissal from class so that unnecessary calls to you may be avoided. If your child arrives after 9:00 AM you must come into the office to sign your child in. The school office phone number is 313-827-6300. You can leave a message 24 hours on the Attendance line (313) 827-6301. When leaving a message, please speak clearly, say the name of the child, the date and reason for

absence, and the student's teacher. Or you may report your child's attendance through Parent Connect.

Please try to avoid signing your child out after 3:00 PM. Many of our specials classes take place in the afternoon and teachers are preparing students for dismissal. Also, please be mindful about picking your child up on time when school lets out.

Breakfast:

Free Breakfast is served daily from 8:35 AM-8:50 AM. If interested, they may enter the building from the staff parking lot door (door 2). Students will not be allowed entry to the building before 8:35 AM. *Remember not to use the staff parking lot for pick-up and drop-off and remind your child to not cut through the staff parking lot when getting dropped-off or picked-up, use the sidewalks only.*

Recess:

Parents/Guardians, we kindly ask that you do not engage with students while they are outside during recess. Our number one priority is student safety and often times teachers are unaware if you're a parent speaking to your child or another student. Teachers will announce "Stranger Danger" to their students and escort them back into the building if they see an adult speaking to a student through the fence, regardless of whether they are the parent of the student or not. The same goes for driving around the building while your student is outside for recess. If you need to relay a message to your student, please either call the front office or contact your students teacher. Thank you so much for your understanding.

As the weather changes it is important that students are dressed appropriately. We recommend sending your child to school with layers as the mornings are becoming cooler and the afternoons tend to warm up. Please be sure to send your child to school with appropriate shoes as well....ex: tennis shoes for gym, rain boots, snow boots etc. Our goal is to go outside during recess every chance that we get unless it is raining outside or temperature/wind chill drops below 20 degrees F.

Food Allergies and Medication:

If your child has a food allergy please notify your child's teacher or the front office immediately.

If your child needs medication during school hours you must stop by the front office to fill out a medication disbursement form. Parents and guardians are not to send students to school with medication.

Snacks:

Please only send in healthy snacks for your student. Student are not allowed to have chips, cookies, cakes, candy etc for snack time. If needed, the office will provide students with crackers

Lost and Found:

Please be sure to label your child's items when sending them to school, Feel free to check out our Lost and Found across from the front office, before or after school. Items will be donated periodically throughout the year.
