HLV ACADEMIC MENTOR: Are you a 9th,10th, 11th or 12th grader at HLV? Are you looking for an opportunity to fill your study hall with a better use of your time? Are you looking to earn Silver Cord hours? Do you enjoy working with younger students? Would you enjoy helping in an elementary classroom? If you answered yes to any of these questions or even if you didn't answer yes but are Curious, stop in the office to pick up information on how to become an HLV Academic Mentor in the elementary for the first semester.

SOPHOMORES: Sophomores have the opportunity of taking the PSATs (Pre-SATs) in October. One of the reasons for your student to begin practicing taking a college entrance exam is to prepare and practice so they score higher on their actual SATs or ACTs which may put them into scholarship range at the college/university of your choice. It also enters your student in the National Merit Scholarship Program which gives high scoring students full ride scholarships to universities around the United States. This test will also enter them into a scholarship database which will open up scholarships around the nation for you to apply for. The cost of the PSAT is \$18 payable the day of the test.
