Practices will be X:XX - X:XX at Cocopah field 2 on Monday and Cocopah Field 1 on Wednesdays starting this Wednesday 2/5, I will upload our practice schedule in GameChanger ASAP. Make sure you have cleats and baseball pants ready and plenty of water. Any color baseball pants will work for practices. We are only slotted for 90 minutes, so be there early, loosen up and ready to take the field at X:XX on the nose.

Our practice schedule may change once the game schedule is announced, just be aware of this and I will let you know. Games will mostly adhere to the Thursday/Saturday format we have grown accustomed to, but there will be deviations due to interleague play.

Our primary objective for this season is to develop athletes for the more competitive All Stars season which is the road to the LL World Series. If you are in the market for a high quality glove our own MRLL family Peralta Custom Gloves is growing leaps and bounds since I picked up their first glove a couple years ago and provide our boys with <a href="https://peraltacustomgloves.com/">https://peraltacustomgloves.com/</a>. In addition, <a href="Baseball Express">Baseball Express</a> and <a href="Baseball Savings">Baseball Savings</a> have a ton of great deals on equipment and I have found Baseball Savings is the best place to purchase pants.

Outside of that, I have scored a great gently used \$400 bat for \$100 using the app SidelineSwap. Modern bats are typically better after a break in period, so used bats are usually better than brand new. **Only certified USA stamped bats are approved for the Little League**, anything with *USSSA or BBCOR* on the handle is not allowed. If the USA baseball stamp is not on the handle, the bat will be removed from the dugout. If you are unsure about a bat, let me know and I will help.

For practice, make sure your players are properly equipped. Glove, cleats, baseball pants, hat, protective cup, **plenty of water**, and any additional equipment they prefer (i.e. personal helmet, etc.).

## **Planning Needs:** I will be looking for as soon as possible;

- A Signup Genius guru to set up/manage our post game snack schedule.
- Anyone who wants to assist with coaching at practices will need to pass a background check with the league. Let me know and I will orient accordingly.
- A scorekeeper/pitch counter to log games in the GameChanger app. A couple of backup scorekeepers just in case.
- Do you have a medical background? In case an emergency arises either at practice or games as my EMT license expired 15 years ago.
