– Introduction

SoP (Spectrum of Personality) is a typology system created by @fipilled/kazutaos on tiktok (click [here](#) for my linktree) that has twenty types, which are split into four categories (thinkers, feelers, doers, and relationships), meaning that there are five types put into the four categories.

To type yourself in this system, you have to choose one type from each category that you relate to most, along with an optional subtype (0-2), then rank from strongest to weakest. You can either not have a subtype, or have a subtype in all four categories. For example, AN(io)-PR(nu)-CR(vi)-ME(ha). A subtype must be in the same category as the primary type. If someone were to have two subtypes, it would be typed out in an AN(in-st) format, or it can be typed out as AN(io=st) if the two subtypes are about the same level of relatability. Certain primary types can as well be around relatability level, and it would be typed out as AN(io)=PR(nu)-CR(vi)-ME(ha) (just putting a = instead of a - sign).

If someone does not relate to any of the five types in the category, then they may exclude the category entirely. For example, if someone doesn't relate to any of the doers types, they wouldn't include the doers category and just have their type as AN(io)-PR(nu)-ME(ha).
