The Dryden Central School District, in collaboration with the Groton Central School district and Covenant Love Community School invites applications for a temporary, grant funded, Coordinator of Learning Technology position.

POSITION OVERVIEW:

The Coordinator of Learning Technology will assist students and teachers with the implementation of the NYS Computer Science and Digital Fluency standards, provide professional development for teachers where appropriate, and establish local work-based learning experiences for students so they are College and Career Ready. Must be passionate, driven, and willing to think "out-of-the-box."

QUALIFICATIONS: (minimum)

1. Valid NYSED certification as a School District or School Building Leader preferred.
2. Master's Degree in education or related field.
3. Successful experience in public school administration/supervision and as department head and/or curriculum coordinator preferred, but not required.
4. Knowledge of adult learning and experience providing professional development.
5. Effective development and management of budget, inventory, purchasing and scheduling.
6. Ability to work well and effectively with, and secure respect of, faculty, staff, students, parents, community groups, local businesses and agencies.
7. Excellent listening, communication, and organizational skills.
8. Creative and collaborative problem solver.
9. Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
10. Licensed driver with the ability to travel between schools and local agencies (mileage reimbursed).

JOB GOAL:

To monitor and implement the goals of the Learning Technology Grant:

- Create a regional network, with dedicated leadership, focused on addressing issues of equity through increased opportunities for personalized learning and postgraduate employment.
- Develop district capacity to offer Middle and High School courses aligned to the NYS Computer Science and Digital Fluency Standards.
- Prepare students for employment in our community.
- Integrate NYS Computer and Digital Fluency Standards throughout the curriculum for all students.
- Increase teacher ability to utilize digital tools and implement standards through personalized coaching, facilitated work sessions, and “just in time” technical support.
