a. Radiation Safety Program (Calibration) (NFD)

K.D. Analytics has agreed to conduct calibration / analysis of the BERT RAD gear. Monitors have already been dropped off by Lexington, and Johnny Adams is working with K.D. Analytics on the additional BERT gear.

b. BERT (show and tell) (Fall of 2024)

Still scheduling for a Saturday morning in the Fall. Will decide on a final date at the June meeting.

c. Tornado exercise (LFD)(CSEPP)

- Still sked for June 12th. 0800 will be the kickoff time.

- Chris Ward still needs solid numbers to determine the composition of the Rescue Squads, to include enough to conduct shift turnover during the exercise
- Chief Ward is meeting with the IMT's on My 15th. The IMT's will be creating the IAP's
- EX plan is to have 3 victims requiring extrication, to include Breach / Break, Lift, Move tasks. This will be in the context of a building collapse / rubble pile.
- There will also be a deployment of Search teams to the Masterson Station neighborhood to simulate rapid damage assessment / SARCOP entry.
 Scenario will an area of residential and light industrial building collapses.
 Moe will be providing engineers to support the assessments.

VI. Announcements / Information Sharing

- a) Drone Software: The invoice has been received for the software purchase approved at the previous meetings. Matt Blose got the license info on May 13, and is working on a dashboard for wider access.
- b) Training: Up to 20 25 in-person training option is available, in addition to an online option for the "pre-course work". Hands-on training would then follow.
- c) Funding: Drew proposed funding "Scholarships" to help offset the costs for the Pilot Exam. Discussion was held on the merits of up front funding vs. reimbursement approach. Three agencies have expressed an interest so far in taking the exams.
 - Chief Jenkins from Clark County said he has a qualified operator willing to give prep training for those wishing to take the exam. Chief Ward expressed an interest.
 - Drew proposed scholarship funding for the first 10 personnel who successfully pass the exams on a reimbursement basis.
 - A motion by Chief Ward / Second by Matt Blose to set aside \$1,750 in scholarship funding for the first 10 operators who pass the exam was approved unanimously on a voice vote.
