Crisis Response Guidelines for Administrators

- Report the death of a current student or staff member
- Report a situation which requires additional mental health support
- Principal contacts the Area Superintendent, Security (Carlis Williams), and Crisis Line

Staff Awareness of Childhood Trauma Indicators

- Sucidie and self-injury screenings (two adults)
- Child protective services reporting (adults are mandatory reporters)
- Threat assessment tool
- OASIS documentation of risk (social workers, psychologists, counselors, and principals have access)

Lockdown Procedures and Best Practices

- Code Yellow place CODE YELLOW LOCKDOWN signs on inside of door
- Conduct drills unannounced; consider running a drill during a difficult time (lunch, RIDGE Time, etc.)
- Recommended within first 30-45 days of school and first 30-45 of new semester
- Keep an old or ERD laptop in command center for ease of camera viewing

- Function together with shared campuses program a principal channel into radios for communication
- Laminate school maps, use dry erase pens to draw directions, tie or attach master keys to maps for first responders
- Keep HDMI cords handy to view cameras on large screens in the command center
- Batteries, flash lights, EOP copies, classroom rosters, medical records, first aid

Severe Weather

• Have a severe weather radio in good condition, properly programmed, and within listening distance of an employee at times (program radio to 162.450)

Lockdown Training

- Basic Lockdown Training and Command Center (advanced training) videos are available on the WCPSS Security Department website under the orange training bucket workspaces page ("Lockdown Training")
- Code red don't close exterior blinds or shades
- Emergency Red Card used only if needed
- Staff meeting held at the end of the day after a code red lockdown

Procedures for Administrators

- Physical address of school needed
- Incident school needs to contact adjacent schools
- Know the roles of each person

<u>Tabletops</u>

- Armed intruder on campus during lunch
- Key personnel to manage the emergency needed
- Administration should take lead when possible
