September 3rd (Wednesday): Nomination papers for Class Officers available via email and informational meeting

September 9th @ 3:15 (Tuesday): Signed nomination papers and campaign speech for Class Officers must be turned in to stuco@email.medfield.net by the end of the school day. Campaign speech videos should be no longer than 2 minutes and should express why you are qualified for your position in a formal manner. Only the candidate may be in the speech video. Speeches will be reviewed and approved by Ms. Safer before they are sent to your class.

Now through **September 12th (Friday):** Open campaign time for Class Officers. Students must have any posters, flyers, etc. approved and signed by Ms. Hagan prior to running them off and putting them up (with blue tape) around the school.

September 11th (Thursday): Video of speeches get sent out to your class.

September 12th (Friday): Class Officer elections held online. Results announced at the end of the school day.

CLASS OFFICER DESCRIPTIONS

President: Responsible for leading the class; calls and runs meetings; oversees events, fundraisers, etc.; represents the class before administration; must be organized and willing to work hard in order to get things done.

Vice President: Responsible for helping the President with all events; takes over for the President when he/she is not able to be present; leader of committees that are established by the grade; serves as a representative to the Student Council.

Secretary: Responsible for taking minutes at all meetings; keeps a record of all meetings; responsible for all letters, notes, flyers, posters, communication, etc.

Treasurer: Responsible for collecting and keeping track of class dues and money raised during fundraisers; must work with Ms. Fitzgerald in the main office to keep track of the class budget.

Representative to the School Committee: Responsible for attending all School Committee meetings; must report to the School Committee everything that the class is working on or any concerns; serves as a representative to the Student Council.
