Note: In October 2022, President Nelson shared the Church's plan to announce multiple temples in major metropolitan areas where travel to existing temples presents an undue hardship. He then explained that Mexico City Mexico would be the first major city to have multiple temples announced simultaneously. Based on research about that announcement, the following metropolitan areas seem likely to have multiple temples simultaneously announced in future General Conferences: Sao Paulo and Rio de Janeiro Brazil, Buenos Aires Argentina, Manila Philippines, and Santiago Chile. Since I don't have access to any data pointing to which of these cities might be the next to have multiple temples announced, I won't be able to predict the order in which those cities could have multiple temples announced, nor will I venture more specific predictions for locations within any of these metropolitan areas.

**Result:** 17 new temples were announced, 1 in each of the following locations: Juchitán de Zaragoza, Mexico; Santa Ana, El Salvador; Medellín, Colombia; Santiago, Dominican Republic; Puerto Montt, Chile; Dublin, Ireland; Milan, Italy; Abuja, Nigeria; Kampala, Uganda; Maputo, Mozambique; Coeur d'Alene, Idaho; Queen Creek, Arizona; El Paso, Texas; Huntsville, Alabama; Milwaukee, Wisconsin; Summit, New Jersey; and Price, Utah.
