CLASSES OVERVIEW

HeartCode Format

- Student must purchase HeartCode from an AHA distributor
- True adaptive learning—length varies by competency
- Written exam online
- Skills certificate:
 - Starts w/ IMP or long hyphenated code (hospital)
- Bring certificate to instructor for skills

Skills identical to Instructor-Led format

BLS

- For medically licensed personnel / students (CNA / RN / MD etc.)
- Adult / Child / Infant required
- Includes advanced airways
- Includes 1-rescuer / 2-rescuer / team dynamics

BLS ILT Testing & Remediation (Instructor Manual Part 4)

- Written + skills tests
- Written exam requires 84%
- Feedback: private / confidential / constructive / practical
- Remediation:
 - Formal = retake test
 - Informal = review missed questions verbally

HeartSaver

- CPR + First Aid + BBP
- For non-healthcare workers (daycare / manufacturing etc.)
- Same layout as BLS manual
- Every lesson starts with real-world scenario → instruction → practice

CPR

- No pulse checks
- 1-rescuer skills only
- Mouth-to-mouth / mouth-to-mask only
- Adult required; Child + Infant optional

• Optional modules = stand-alone (so repetitive)

First Aid

Required + optional modules Agenda categories include:

- First Aid Basics
- Medical Emergencies
- Injury Emergencies
- Environmental Emergencies
- Preventing Illness & Injury
- Legal Questions

HeartSaver Testing

- Written exam is optional
- CPR Adult & Infant skills → identical to BLS
- First Aid → 4 tests:
 - Finding the problem
 - Taking off gloves
 - o Stopping bleed
 - o EpiPen

HeartSaver Total

OSHA version

HeartSaver K-12

- Same DVD / books / tests
- Different card for K-12 students & staff

Family & Friends

- Non-required audiences (church, new parents, etc.)
- Hands-only CPR
- No certification

TC POLICIES

- All paperwork must be kept for 3 years. Paperwork must be entered into Hovn
- Students must have a student manual
- Use course videos for all classes. ILT and Skills sessions
- ACLS/PALS provider cards do not take the place of a BLS provider card
- No training international
- No virtual classes
- Training locations

Commercial or Business Locations

Must be held in a private, dedicated room within a commercial or office space. Shared-use coworking spaces (e.g. WeWork) are permitted if the room is reserved for exclusive use during class hours.

Onsite Training at Client Facilities

Acceptable if the business, school, or organization has a clearly designated training space.

Outdoor Classes

Permitted only when:

- The instructor has a valid reason (e.g., a community outreach event or CPR in the Park initiative)
- The space is quiet, shaded, and clearly set up for training
- All equipment, manikins, and supplies are present and protected

Prohibited Locations

- Restaurants or cafes open to the public (e.g. Starbucks, Panera)
- Living rooms or kitchens inside private residences
- Hotel lobbies or other shared spaces without a private reservation
- Any venue that lacks privacy, safety, or professional appearance

TEACHING TECHNIQUES

- Build rapport immediately
- Favorite teacher reflection
- Multi-modality retention:
 - o 10% read

- 20% hear
- o 30% see
- 50% see + hear
- o 80% see / hear / do

Best Practices

- Don't pause video or talk over video
- Follow lesson maps
- Light commentary between videos
- Don't hover over one student—observe group
- Voice must fill room
- Be confident & directive
- Demonstrate before floor practice
- Reinforce by asking questions (not repeating video)

SKILLS PRACTICE ALGORITHM

- 1. Ask student a question
- 2. Student responds
- 3. Give feedback
- 4. Repeat

Why

- Keeps group aligned
- Allows targeted calling on shy students

SKILLS PRACTICE / TESTING

NOTES

- Before each skill: cover "tips" + common errors
- Assign a candidate to lead skill
- Some skills repeat 2–3x w/ rotating leader

Skills:

- Assessment (up to 3 candidates)
- Compressions
- Pocket Mask (2 candidates lead)
- AED (2 candidates lead)
- BVM
- Infant Compressions
- Infant BVM
- Infant Choking (2 candidates lead)
- Rescue Breathing
- Adult & Infant Skills Test (each student facilitates)
