It was lovely to see so many families join us for our first school assembly on Friday. Well done to Vinny Kitto and Holly Campbell who did a great job of leading the first assembly. This year our school assemblies will be fortnightly, which means our next assembly will be on Friday 7th March. The following assembly coincides with the Year 8 Rail Trail Challenge, so this will be moved to the following week, Friday 28th March. Assembly dates are included in the events below.

As mentioned in an earlier newsletter, students have been working together to develop class and playground norms (expectations)—guidelines for positive behaviour and ways of working. One of the playground expectations is that bikes are walked to and from the bike track. This is to ensure the safety of those who are playing on the courts and walking around the school. We would really appreciate your help with this before and after school, when the school grounds are particularly busy. If you have a preschooler on a bike or scooter please ensure that they only ride on the bike track.

We have a number of exciting EOTC events happening next week. Fingers crossed that the brilliant summer days continue for these activities.

- On Monday our junior school will be heading to Omakau for a day trip to Ben and Anna Gillespies farm and to the Thomson Catchment Project near Ōmakau. They will spend the morning learning about work on the farm and visiting a stream on the property where the Gillespies have planted native trees to protect the waterways and the afternoon will be spent at the Thomson Catchment Project area.
- On Tuesday our year 6 children will head away on camp with Mrs Fitzgerald and Miss Robertson to Lake Ohau. They have some really exciting activities lined up, including a trip on the Tasman Glacier boats.
- On Tuesday we have a bike challenge for our seniors. Our year 4 & 5 students will bike into Alexandra via the rail trail for a swim at the Molyneux Aquatic Centre and our year 7 & 8 students will bike to the pool via the river track. Everyone will bike back to school on the rail trail.
- On Friday our Year 8 Bike Ambassadors will run some bike skills sessions for our junior classes.

A number of these activities require parent support to accompany us on these EOTC adventures. Further details about the activities that pertain to your child / children have been shared via the HERO app. Please let your child's classroom teacher know if you are able to help with any of these activities.

This year's **Year 4-8 school athletic sports** will be held at Molyneux Stadium on Monday 10th March. The senior school athletic sports events will be run by our middle and senior teachers, but as mentioned in an earlier newsletter, with the absence of our junior school teachers we will require a number of parent helpers for each event. 
