- For the mentally and physically impaired candidates and those who suffer psychomotor disorders the headteacher must write a letter on the same which **MUST** be accompanied by **a recent detailed medical doctor's report**, a **full size photograph for physical disability**, an **Education Assessment Resource Centre (EARC)** officers assessment report on each of candidate's functional ability. **Candidates whose doctors' medical reports are not received will NOT be considered for any assistance during the examination time.**
- Low vision candidates must also have a medical report from certified medical doctors.
- If the school does not have any candidate(s) in any of the above categories the headteacher must indicate **Nil** and submit the form to the council together with the registration materials.
