Tournament Rules

- 1. Tournament will use the ISC rules of play. 2 Out catcher rule is optional.
- 2. All games are 7 innings. No new inning will start after 1HR and 45 Mins in the round robin. Once an inning has started it must be completed. No time limit on playoff games.
- 3. International tiebreaker rule is in effect. If it is still tied once the time limit is reached the game will end in a tie in the round robin.
- 4. The mercy rule is 7 runs after 5, 10 runs after 4, and 15 runs after 3.
- 5. A player cannot play for more than 1 team. Players can only play in one division, with the exception of U20 or younger players. They may play for 1 Open team and 1 Rec team.
- 6. Any player or coach ejected from a game will serve a 1 game suspension.
- 7. All decisions made by the tournament committee will be final.
- 8. Consumption of outside alcohol is not permitted. Any team caught doing so will be ejected from the tournament and forfeit their entry fee. Alcohol is to only be consumed in the designated area.
- 9. Tie breaker rules are as follows:
 - 1. Head to Head if applicable
 - 2. Plus/Minus: runs for minus runs against (Cannot be more than a difference of 7 runs per game)
 - 3. Least Runs against
 - 4. Most Runs for
 - 5. Most Homeruns hit
 - 6. Coin Flip
- 10. A coin flip will decide the home team 45 minutes before each game in the pavilion. Line up cards will be provided to hand into umpires at the home plate meeting before games.
- 11. The highest seeded team will be the home team for all playoff games.
- 12. Teams must be ready to play at least 15 minutes before scheduled start time.
- 13. NO ISC prawn pitchers can pitch in the rec division. No player on a National Team 40 man roster is allowed to play in the rec division.
