Dear Students,

We have some exciting changes to our writing curriculum, which provides more flexibility for our writing students.

Beginning Fall 2026, Literary Studies majors with a Writing concentration will be required to take the following:

- One introductory course in fiction, poetry or nonfiction.
- After their introductory course, students will be free to explore a variety of three 3000-level topical workshops across genres, figuring out which genre they'd like to devote more time to as they progress.
- Once students complete three 3000-level courses of their choice, they will take one 4000-level topical workshop of their choice. *Students should have taken at least one 3000-level course in this genre.

- Students will continue their work in the same genre they explored in their 4000-level course for their final capstone course.
