What the COAH Expects From You, Player

1. Bring a positive attitude and a strong desire to improve at every practice and game.
2. Commit to attending all scheduled trainings and games throughout the season.
3. Treat teammates, coaches, opponents, referees, and families with respect at all times.
4. Arrive prepared with proper equipment (shin guards, correct footwear, ball, water, and training gear).
5. Take ownership of your development by practicing independently outside of team sessions.
6. Stay focused, disciplined, and accountable on and off the field.
7. Communicate absences in advance through your parent/guardian.
8. Be open to feedback and committed to continuous growth as a player and person.

What COACH Expects From You, Parent

9. Ensure your child arrives on time and prepared for all trainings and games.
10. Encourage your player to take responsibility for their equipment, preparation, and attitude.
11. Support the coaching staff and allow them to lead all technical instruction.
12. Complete registrations, payments, and required forms on time.
13. Contribute to the team by supporting volunteer roles when needed.
14. Model respect toward referees, opponents, and all members of the community.
15. **Do not coach from the sidelines** — instead, provide positive encouragement.

What You Can Expect From Seatown FC Coaches

16. Clear communication of expectations from the beginning to the end of the season.
17. A respectful, structured, and positive team environment.
18. A developmental approach focused on long-term player growth.
19. Organized, challenging, and purposeful training sessions.
20. Emphasis on character, discipline, leadership, and teamwork.
21. Recognition of effort, improvement, and team accomplishments.

Financial Commitment & Program Structure:

As every year, **Seatown FC Foundation** offers a **Sliding Fee Scale** to ensure that all families have access to our program. We provide flexible monthly contribution options so each family can select the amount that best fits their situation.

Monthly Contribution Options:

- **\$115** per month
- **\$135** per month
- **\$150** per month

Families may choose the option that best suits their financial ability.

NOTE: Once you register, \$35 will be deducted immediately to cover the season's training uniform, and the first monthly fee will be charged on May 1, 2026.

Late fee Policy:

To ensure the stability and proper operation of **Seatown FC Academy**, the following payment policy will be strictly enforced:

1. Monthly tuition fees will be automatically charged during the first five (5) days of each month.
2. Payments not completed after the 5th day of the month will incur a \$20 late fee, which will be automatically added to the account.
3. Players with outstanding balances exceeding two (2) months of unpaid tuition will unfortunately be removed from the team.
4. In such cases, the roster spot will be offered to a player currently on the academy's waiting list.

Seatown FC Academy is committed to maintaining fairness, organization, and sustainability for all families. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Cancellation Policy

Membership may be canceled at any time. We understand that sometimes circumstances beyond a family's control may require leaving the program.

However, written notice must be submitted at least **20 days before the next billing cycle**. If notice is not provided within that timeframe, cancellation will take effect the **following month**, and the next monthly fee will still be charged.

Seatown FC is here to support and listen to our families. Clear and timely communication is essential so we can work together and find solutions when needed.

What the Monthly Contribution Covers:

- Coaching staff compensation
- Field rentals (subject to city availability)
- Training equipment
- Administrative and organizational costs

In addition, your contribution helps support players from local shelters and underserved families in our community by assisting with mentorship programs, uniforms, tournament fees, and other related expenses.

Training & Competition Structure

1. Training Sessions:

- o 2 training sessions per week (generally Wednesdays and Fridays).
- o Please note: Training days may change without prior notice due to field availability assigned by the city.

2. Competitions:

- o Summer, Fall, Winter, and Spring competitions.

3. Holiday Break:

- o Training break during (December 16 – January 6, 2026)

Seatown FC Academy trainings are primarily held at **Moshier Park**, using both the **synthetic field and the grass field**.

If there are any changes to the training location, the Seatown FC team will notify families in advance with the **updated location, address, and training schedule**.

Please note that Seatown FC adjusts its schedule based on **field availability provided by the city**, as all fields are rented through the city's park system.

Tournament & League Fees

Below you will find the list of summer tournaments and the **NPSL League** in which we will participate this season, along with the cost of each event.

Tournament and league fees are **separate from the monthly contribution**.

The total cost of each tournament will be **divided among the players participating in that specific event**. Payments will be processed through the **TeamSnap application** and will be collected approximately **1–2 weeks prior to the start of the tournament**.

All tournament payments must be completed **before the event begins**.

Players who do not complete tournament registration at least **one week prior to the event** will not be eligible to participate.

Uniform Costs – 2026–2027 Season

- **Training Uniform: \$35**
(This amount will be collected at the time of the registration.)

1 Training Jersey
1 Training Shorts
1 pairs of socks
- **Competition Uniform: \$120**
(Must be purchased at least **2 weeks before the first tournament**.)

2 Game Jerseys (Adidas)
1 Game Shorts
1 pairs of socks

Players who do not have the official competition uniform will not be eligible to participate in tournaments.

If you are ever asked to send payment to a personal account, please notify one of the Directors immediately.
