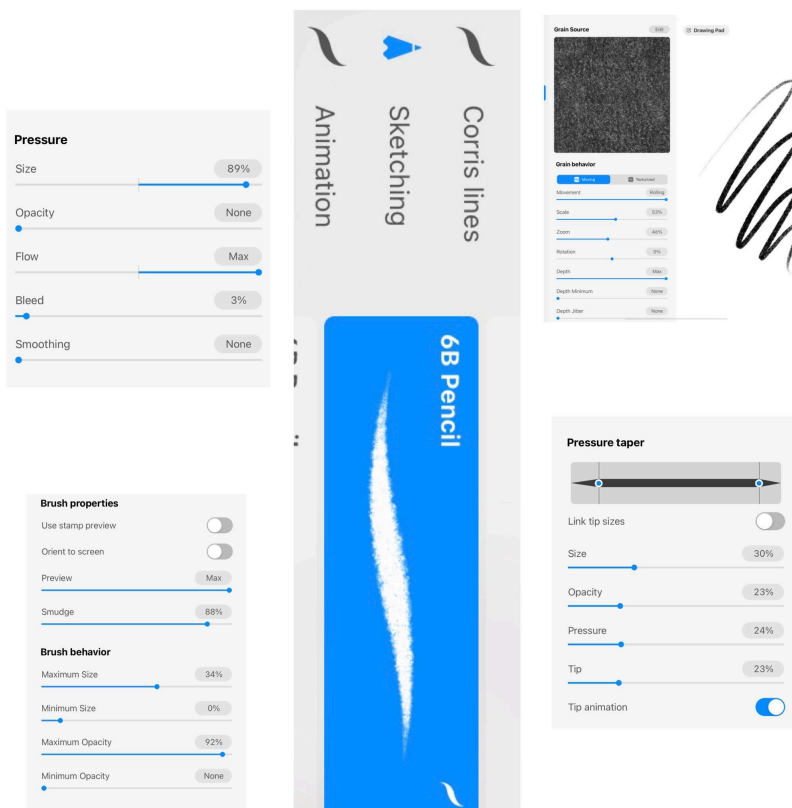

# HB PENCIL (heavily adjusted)- Sketch section

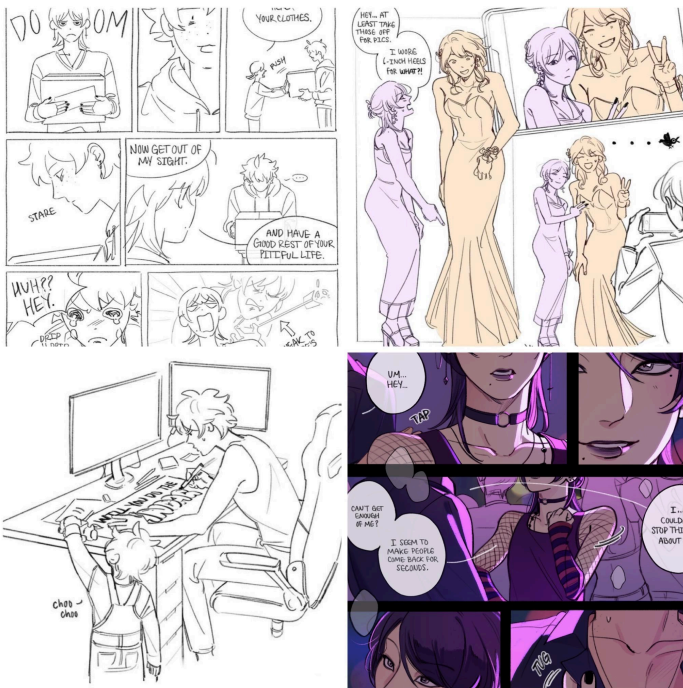
- Lineart

## Round Brush (default settings)-Airbrush section

- Originally named "Hard Airbrush"
- Used for filling in base colors

## Blush Brush (default settings)- Airbrush section

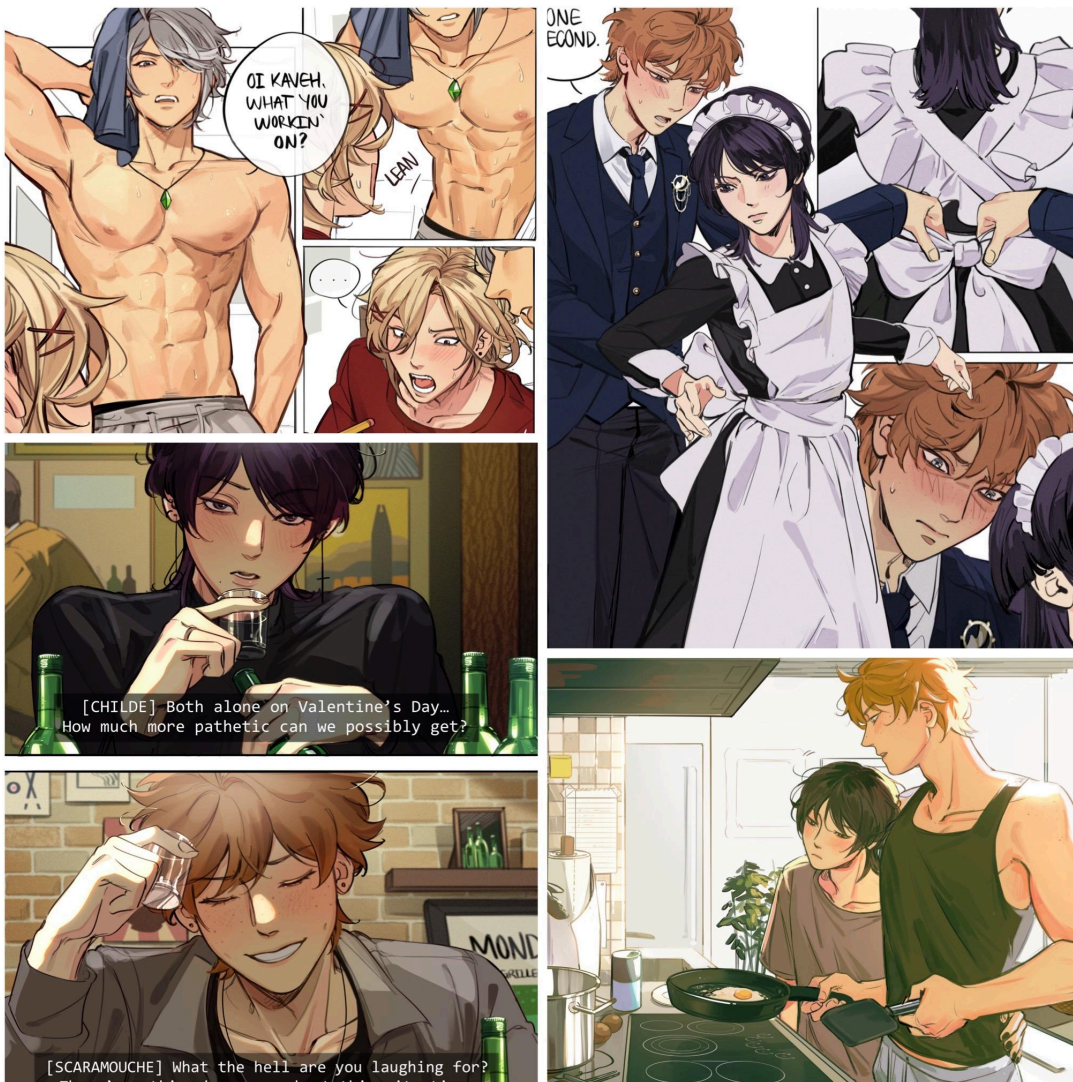
- Originally named "Soft Brush"
- Used for blush spots like cheeks, shoulders, elbows
- Used for soft shading like hair gradients
- Used for lighting effects

## Brush Pen (default settings)- Caligraphy section

- Occasionally used for lineart + rendering

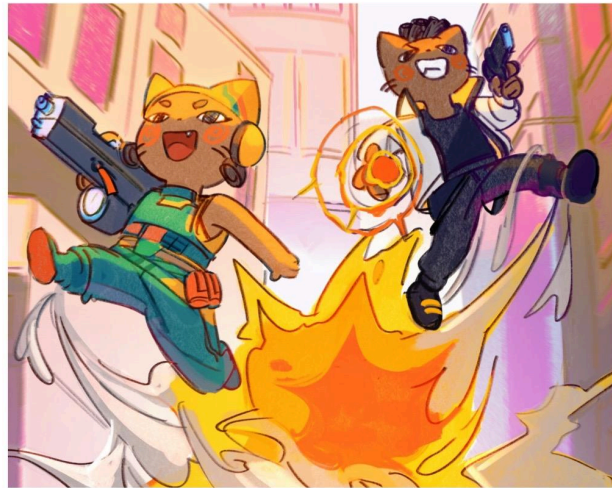
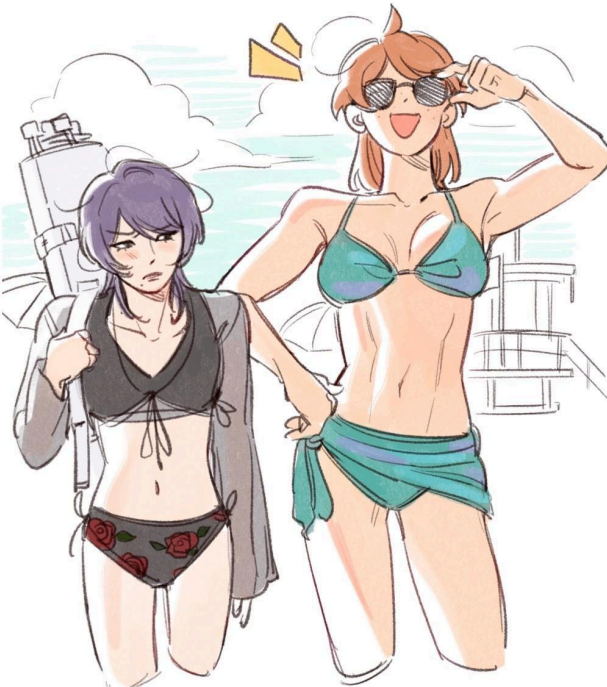


(Used for lineart, rendering, and background)

## Gloaming (default settings)- Drawing section

- Occasionally used for colors
- Pairs well with [HB brush](#)

(All drawings except bottom right used HB brush for lineart. Bottom right used gloaming brush for lineart, rendering, and background.)

## Peppermint (opacity adjusted to be higher)- Sketch section

- Used for lineart
