- 2. Principal's Report Shawn McAleer

Safety meeting update: have a new report for taking vitals/can record kids info during the drills or a way to keep all kids accounted for (additional accountability piece). Attendance is in by 9:15 and the Safety director can oversee that. Concerns that teachers may see at recess or carpool (checking doors and swipe for safety). Accountability is the key piece in any drill. Lockdown, lockout, offsite and onsite evacuation drills. (all meet in the gym and parents pick up). Offsite would be at the high school (state mandated) and monthly fire drills. Talked about doing tabletop drills. Safety is number 1 on their minds always.

Boosterthon - a lot of teachers commented that it was a Pyramid Scheme. Feedback from parents as well (emails with negative comments). Mr Malcom had a great connection with the kids (very positive energy in the building). Concerns with the prizes (and kids being excluded from prizes) and confusion with events per day. Run day was great and kids loved it. If we were to do it again, not October (kids still learning procedures), eliminate the prizes, and if we could meet with the Boosterthon and set rules (everyone is doing pajama day). Less focus on the donation/money part. Raised 26,000 dollars for our school. (about 50,000 total and half goes to Booster, half to our school). We also got corporate sponsors. Discussed the option of doing a fun run in the future (without the money raising piece) but likely 1 and done for this. Data meetings are this time of year (3 times a year) data meetings are reading focused (little touch of math). Mr. Mac, all of kindergarten, 2 reading specialists and ISS teacher. Different reading assessments and a chance for sharing the reading groups and a chance to share any other kids they're concerned about. Tier 1 is kids that aren't getting any reading support. Tier 2 is needing support within the room (might work through guided reading). Tier 3 are kids being pulled out. Each reading special has 9 groups. And then another meeting in the winter and a spring meeting. Some kids stay in reading groups through 5th, some are in and out. **Upcoming events** - scheduling date for Kindergarten sing-along, usually the Friday or Wed before Thanksgiving. This will be in Patriot Press Thursday.

3rd/4th grade Chorus is going to Harrisburg (singing holiday songs at the capitol building) planned for early Dec.
