3	The name of the institution of each author listed only the names of colleges or corporate institutions. Example: Library and Information Science Study Program, Universitas Padjadjaran	
4	The affiliation address of all authors consisting of: Faculties/divisions/departments etc., address, city, postal code, country and email of each author 10pt. Book Antiqua, Capital Each Word, center, space 1
