We are excited to announce the launch of a **free** lunchtime Math Support Program for students in **Grades 9 and 10**. This 8-week program is designed to help students struggling with core math concepts or who would like to strengthen their understanding and confidence in math. We will work on key skills like numeracy, algebra, graphing, fractions, measurement, and statistics.

For students currently enrolled in math this semester, the program offers targeted reinforcement of core skills needed to be successful in math. For those taking math next semester, it provides a valuable opportunity to refine key skills in preparation for their upcoming class.

Unlike Nelson's lunchtime drop-in math clinic (Mon and Wed), this is a structured program; attendance will be taken each week. While we will focus on curricular expectations, we will not necessarily follow the curriculum along with classroom teachers. Students should not use this program to get help with classroom homework. Moreover, the program will not give homework or conduct evaluations; it is just a program to practice and refine math skills.
