Secondary AMI (Virtual Learning) Guidance

Before Virtual Learning Day:

- Ensure students know how to access:
 - Canvas, Google Meet, Online Classroom Resources
- Ensure students are accustomed to communicating with teachers via district email
- Ensure students understand teacher expectations for participation in virtual learning
 - Hand Raise Icon, Collaborative Structures, Chat Features

During Virtual Learning Day:

- Students will follow a shortened version of their 7-period schedule
- Students are expected to attend and participate in the live class sessions
- Students are expected to submit evidence of their learning
- Core and Elective Teachers will follow a shortened version of their 7-period schedule
- Teachers will lead an online, synchronous instructional session at the beginning of each class period (15-20 min)
- The lesson will be a continuation of the content currently being taught in the course, and should be connected to priority standards and standards assessed frequently on the MAP/EOC Assessment
