1) **Taipei Wins Special Mention at Lee Kuan Yew World City Prize** 臺北市獲頒李光耀世界城市獎特別獎

Taipei has just made history over in Singapore.

The city has taken home a Special Mention at the prestigious Lee Kuan Yew World City Prize—marking the very first time a city in Taiwan has picked up the honor.

Taipei Mayor Chiang Wan-an was there in person to accept the award. During his keynote lecture, titled "Human Touch in a Smart City," Mayor Chiang told global leaders that while high-tech systems and economic growth are great, Taipei's real secret weapon is putting people first.

In a memorable moment, Chiang compared Taipei to a classic Taiwanese hot pot—saying the city brings all kinds of different people and cultures together to create something inclusive, warm, and full of energy.

He wrapped up by dedicating the big win to generations of city workers and, of course, to the residents of Taipei themselves.

2) **Taipei Hosts the 2026 Rotary International Convention** 臺北主辦2026國際扶輪年會

For the first time in over thirty years, the global spotlight is right here on Taipei as the city hosts the massive Rotary International Convention.

This year's event has drawn an incredible crowd—over 37,000 attendees from more than 140 countries. The convention even features a highly anticipated keynote speech by Nobel Peace Prize laureate Malala Yousafzai.

While the main meetings are taking place in the Taipei Dome, another major highlight is over at the Nangang Exhibition Center. That's where the "House of Friendship" is showcasing Rotary's charity work alongside a vibrant taste of local culture.

Taipei Mayor Chiang Wan-an welcomed all the Rotary members, calling the event a profound honor and a major vote of confidence for the city.

3) **Taipei Children's Arts Festival Returns This Summer 2026** 臺北兒童藝術節

Summer is officially here, and one of Taipei's favorite family events is back.

The annual Taipei Children's Arts Festival kicks off on June 30 and runs through August 6. The festival will bring six weeks of theater, music, dance, and other performing arts programs designed especially for children and teenagers.

This year's ticketed programs feature performing groups from seven countries, including France, Australia, Belgium, Spain, Indonesia, Thailand, and Taiwan.

But families do not always need a ticket to join the fun. The festival's popular Community Tour will bring free performances to neighborhoods across Taipei's 12 districts. No registration or advance booking is needed. Families can simply arrive, line up, and enjoy the shows together. Doors open 30 minutes before each performance.

4) World Cup Ballroom Dance Open Comes to Taipei 2026 CTC世界盃國標舞公開賽7/4決戰小巨蛋

Taipei is set to dazzle this summer as it hosts the 2026 CTC World Cup International Ballroom Dance Open. The competition takes place July 4th at Taipei Arena, with more than 1,100 dancers expected to take the floor. The event is officially sanctioned by the World Dance Council.

Top international judges and world-class performers will be in attendance, including champions from the renowned Blackpool Dance Festival.

A special highlight this year is the gala final, where dancers will perform to live music by the Taipei Philharmonic Orchestra and the Music Line Jazz Orchestra—blending classical and jazz on stage.

The public is warmly invited to Taipei Arena on July 4th to witness world-class performances, experience the highest level of international ballroom dance competition.

5) Taipei Invites Pet Owners to Free Dog Park Event 「景勤有愛 認證秀出來」寵物活動

Pet lovers in Taipei have something to look forward to this month. On June 27, the Animal Protection Office will host “Show Your Love at Jingqin” at the Jingqin Dog Activity Area, right beside the Xinyi shopping district.

The event celebrates iSCO Corporation's adoption of the park under Taipei's dog park program. Free rabies shots and pet registration will be available for both dogs and cats.
