"Inclusiveness" was a prevailing theme in my TA

My TA is picking up on work begun by the student voice committee. All of their ideas seemed to connect with the importance of balancing student voice with adult priorities.

## What worked for you and/or for your advisees?

I noticed that kids were quick to think of accomplishments and dreams for themselves but were harder pressed to think community-wide- but they did come up with the hope of having a great prom this year.

- The timing was good. First semester was over and people seemed happy about a new start.
- Not a whole lot on this activity.
- It was so nice to have materials ready to go!
- pre-planned questions/prompts, the ideas that everyone was doing it, combining with our partner TA, writing first as individuals and then sharing out loud to whole group
- Some of the older students stepped up and gave personal examples
- The materials provided were good and clear directions-knowing that we had to share for community meeting
- It worked well combining my TA with Kate's TA-two adults helped the kids take it seriously
- The steps of what we wrote and then shared worked well
- The Tuesday writing worked well. The directions worked well too so that my students were able to participate in the activity without me there.
- The template was helpful, otherwise they wouldn't have shared anything with one another...

## What would you do differently or wished was done differently?

- Come up with a different way to introduce this to students. "Dream board, led to immediate disinterest.
- Figure out a way to have more group discussion
- Made more of a connection to MLK- maybe watch part of his speech.
- seemed ok that my seniors were not there, but I think I would have prefered to have them present to help with continuity
- more lead time to prepare
- What to do with students who refused to participate?
- Need more time because the first day seniors were out for senior meeting...
- I think three days would have been better, but I probably would have budgeted two as well.

I would echo the more time. Normally this isn't an issue but because of the participation in the meeting tomorrow we are a bit crunched for time.

Not a big deal, but directions were a bit confusing about how many items each person should write on the big Dream Paper.

• Echo the needed time. Too many components also; goals for next semester would have been a good product. I felt like I did more talking than my students
