Executive Order 021: Creation of the Contract Bid for the MAUAS Program

May 20th, 2020

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, I, Gunnz011, do:

SECTION 1 Background

Since the beginning of this administration, our top defense officials have been looking into the option of MAUASs (Mass Attack Unmanned Aerial Systems). These systems would work in unison to rally around a target to disorient or destroy it. These systems will also be equipped with advanced surveillance capabilities to ensure our warfighters have complete control of any given battlespace. To ensure this project comes to fruition, we will be releasing a public contract bid. Whichever company secures this contract will be working closely with DARPA for initial development and prototyping.

SECTION 2 Contract Bid

- 1) Companies have until September 1st, 2020 to present concept proposals for the MAUAS Program.
- 2) Based on concept proposals, DARPA officials, as well as Department of Defense officials will decide who will go into the prototyping phase. Companies will not be receiving assistance from DARPA during this phase. Companies will have until September 1st, 2022 to complete their submissions.
- 3) Based on prototype submissions, DARPA officials, as well as Department of Defense officials will decide who is awarded the MAUAS Contract. Whoever is awarded this contract will receive full funding from the United States Government, as well as DARPA for further development and production.

SECTION 3 General Provisions

- a) This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
- b) This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against the United States, its departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.
