# • My idea is... (the person, the story)

The Pen is equivalent to the Sword - Gareth Prior. A short documentary looking at Gareth's passion within sword fighting, larp and reenactment.

# • It is an interesting idea (or an important one) because...

# I want to shoot it in the style of...

# I will achieve this by... (planning, testing lighting setups, etc) Having quick cuts of action shots where there are clashes of swords, or arrows being shot. Then to contrast the high stakes actions, moments and interviews of calm and joy.
