

Disabling All (Future) Comments





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Future comments can be disabled by going to the Dashboard and then Settings → Discussion.

Default post settings

- Attempt to notify any blogs linked to from the post
- Allow link notifications from other blogs (pingbacks and trackbacks) on new posts
- Allow people to submit comments on new posts

(These settings may be overridden for individual posts.)

Uncheck “Allow people to submit comments on new posts.”
Make sure to click on “Save Changes” at the bottom of the page.

Allowing Comments on Select Posts or Pages

Posts: From the Dashboard, go to Posts → All Posts.

Pages: From the Dashboard, go to Pages → All Pages.

Either check the box next to the posts or pages from the listing or the box in the upper left-hand corner (to affect all of them). From the menu above the post or page listing, choose “Edit” and then click “Apply.”


