

#### Arriving by Train to Barcelona


TRAINS: use <a href="https://www.raileurope.com">https://www.raileurope.com</a> and aim for Barcelona, from there take a bus to the meeting point. For combinations of trains+buses use <a href="https://www.rome2rio.com/">https://www.rome2rio.com/</a> Booking well in advance can make it much cheaper. If you're travelling from across Europe on the train we've found this website to be really useful to plan journeys <a href="https://www.seat61.com">https://www.seat61.com</a>. # Arriving by Bus to Barcelona

If you are arriving in Barcelona by bus, it will likely stop in either Sants or Estació del Nord. In the first case, follow the directions for Sants just above; in the second case, Estació del Nord is closer to the Nest and is just an **18 minute walk** (see exact location just below).


Where to Park near the Nest City Lab if travelling by car?

Parking BSM Plaça de les Arts **24/7**, C/ de Padilla, 157, Eixample, 08013 Barcelona , <u>here</u>. Parking card 3 days available at 42 Euros

Telpark **24/7**, Carrer de Sancho de Ávila, 35, Sant Martí, 08018 Barcelona <u>Here</u>

# Arriving by Airplane to Barcelona (not recommended):

The most ecological and economical way to get from the T2 airport terminal is to take the Renfe airport train to the Passeig de Gracia station, and then you are just a very short walk to the bus stop. There is also the "L9 Sud" metro line which goes from both T1 and T2 airport terminals to Plaça Catalunya, but you must change trains at the Torrassa station. The easiest and fastest way to get from the airport directly to Plaça Catalunya is to just take the Aerobus, which costs approx €7.



#### Coming with kids?
