Featherweights - McMurdo Station - US Research Station (Ross Island, Antarctica)



Audrey Allen (17-5) vs *Olivia Holt* (*Badass Barbies*)

When you beat a talented opponent and fight them for the second time you can expect them to come out looking for some payback. When I fought Olivia back at UCC IX I pretty much beat her senseless. I was expecting her to come into the cage with a different strategy but she was basically the same fighter who got her ass handed to her. Apparently she likes pain,

I'll admit that she was more focused and won the early rounds but she didn't have enough to put me away. It's probably because she had a good tournament and was coming in with a 4 fight win streak. That didn't stop Olivia and she came out and fought hard and won the final round. I'll admit I was nervous as hell waiting for the decision. I finally get to fight for the title and will duke it out with Catrinel Menghia. This will be the 3rd time we fought each other. Catrinel beat me in our 1st encounter but I dominated her in the last Tournament. I'll be ready so will Catrinel and plan on putting on a show for the Russian.



Kara Monaco (14-6) vs **Victoria Justice** (**Hellfire Girls Club**)

I wish I knew what was happening. 3 months ago I held the Featherweight Title and was the number 4 ranked fighter in the UCC and was coming off one of my best performances to date beating Catrinel Menghia for the title.

On our tie breaker fight she came out and took me down. I stuck my arm out and landed funny breaking my wrist. I shouldn't have entered the 3rd tournament series but I felt my wrist had healed. My 1st fight was against Vail Bloom from the Hot and Dangerous. Vail fought valiantly but I easily beat her. After the fight my wrist was swollen and black and blue. I had the trainer look at it and they assured me that it wasn't broken again and it would be sore for a few days. My next fight against teammate Carly Lauren didn't go well as I was basically a one armed fighter. Carly took it to me and I did my best but wasn't able to fend her off.

I felt that another month off would allow my wrist to heal and I'd be ready to fight Hellfires Victoria Justice. The fight didn't go well and Victoria came out and within the 1st minute landed a head kick that sent me reeling in the fence. Victoria saw I was hurt and never let up and really put a beatdown on me. I;d like to use my wrist as an excuse but truth be told she was the better fighter.



Nikki Leigh (12-7) vs Ariana Grande (Hellfire Girls Club)

This is the 2nd straight event Ariana and I have fought it out in the cage. I was fortunate to lock on an amazing flying omoplata to win the 1st fight and was hoping that I could win again with a similar move.

As you can imagine, Ariana worked on her submission defense and forced me to fight it out on my feet. I really wasn't excited about fighting her on her terms but she left me no choice but to stand and trade with her.

Ariana may be one of the more diminutive fighters barely breaking 5 feet but she is deceptively strong and is fast on her feet. She is shockingly strong with 8 of her 10 wins coming via KO's. I knew if I had to slug it out with her I'd have to be aggressive so I put the pressure on her. I ate a few shots but didn't let up and by the end of the 1st I felt I was winning.

I felt the best path to victory was to tie Ariana up in the clinch, hold her in close so she couldn't use her quickness. By the middle of the 2nd the damage was building up and I tied her in a Muay Thai clinch and started landing knees to the body. After the 2nd knee to her face landed the ref pulled me off.



Carly Lauren (5-1) vs Mercedeh Allen (Queens of the Cage)

When you have early success and climb up the rankings you find yourself fighting opponents who have a lot more cage experience than you do. Mercedeh Allen has been in 14 fights and has had some really impressive wins. I knew that no matter what I threw at her she would have seen it before so my only option was to pick a discipline and beat her at it

Mercedeh and I recently fought Badass Barbie Vanessa Hudgen at the last Tournament Event. Mercedeh took Vanessa deep into the 4th while Vanessa submitted me early in the 1st. As you can imagine my confidence was shaken but I didn't let it get me down and had a good camp.

My trainers felt that Mercedeh would come in feeling that with all of her muscles that she would be able to push me around. I may have a slim figure but I'm very strong for my size. Something Mercedeh quickly found out as I was able to bully her around in the clinch. When she was slow off her stool in the 3rd I knew I had her. I went all out and worked over her body until her guard came down then went upstairs until the ref said that she had enough. It gets 100 times harder as Ariana Grande will be my opponent in Moscow.



Jaclyn Swedberg (8-5) vs Jisoo (BlackPink)

I don't know what it is about fighting Asian women but lately when I fight one of them they kick my ass. I started out my UCC career by beating Olivia Sui and Natasha Yi and thought Asian women were a joke. I was cruising along in the top 15 when Jennie almost took off my head with an uppercut handing me my 1st loss.

I won a few more until Rose kneed me so many times that the ref stopped the fight in the 2nd. I had my best stretch winning 4 fights in a row until Sana punched my light out. Have I mentioned that I can't beat Asian women?

I went to the South Pole knowing that I had to fight Jisoo who is probably the toughest Asian fighter. I felt I had to try something different. Anything different because if it wasn't for Asian fighters my record would be 8-2 and I would be in the top 10. The fights started out great and I knocked off her feet in the opening seconds. Hopefully the curse would be broken but Jisoo had other ideas.

After a few exchanges she started taking me from one end of the cage to the other. By the end of the 1st my face was covered in blood and it felt like my ribs were cracked. I held on as long as I could and made it to 3rd before the ref stopped the fight. I get to fight Lucy Hale from the Badass Barbies and plan on getting an easy win. Lucy is an Asian name but I think she's American. Anyway the fight won't last long.



Sara Jean Underwood (7-7) vs Allie Deberry (Udder Destruction)

I finally did it. I've gotten back to a .500 record and don't plan on ever having a losing record again. I know that 7-7 is mediocre and that I'm only an average fighter but I feel that my past losses were more mental than physical and now that my head is in it. I plan on making a run towards the top.

I knew Allie Deberry was a tremendous ground fighter and likes to swarm all over her opponents and smother them to the ground. We worked almost entirely on my takedown defense and working from the bottom of guard.

The fight plan worked out to perfection. I was able to use my striking to wear Allie down and by the end of the 2nd she was a bloody mess. When the fight went to the mat I was able to keep her from causing any damage and ended the match with some elbows from guard.

My next fight will be against Hitomi Tanaka from the Alpha Angels. Hitomi has to be one of the more well rounded fighters and is dangerous on her feet as well as wrestling on the mat. I'll do my best and no matter where the fight ends up will do everything needed to win.

Lightweights - Davis Station - Australian Research Outpost (Vestfold Hills, Antarctica)



Jessa Hinton (20-2) vs Julianne Hough (Badass Barbies) Title Fight

I love the Centerfold Angels. They have given me all the tools I need to win the Lightweight Title. Since she moved up to Lightweight, Julianne Hough has been my main competition and a thorn in my side. In our 1st 3 fights Julainne had won 2. In fact my only losses were to her. Personally I respect her and she is a true professional but the rest of her stable are a bunch of pompous Divas. I bought this new outfit to show them what a true Barbie looks like.

Jayde Nicole (16-6) vs Dove Cameron (Badass Barbies)

Fighting in the UCC has its ups and downs. I was coming off a Tournament that saw me win the Lightweight Denim Title beating Julianne Hough in the finals. As one would imaging I was on a natural high after gaining the most ranking points and winning fight of the night. I fully planned on continuing my win streak and climbing back into title contention and getting another shot at my teammate Jessa Hinton for the Lightweight Belt.

I flexed my body and twisted my hips and launched a series of punches. I felt that Dove was in trouble and on her way out.

It didn't take long before I had opened up Chelsie and the fight got worse for her. I know that she is stubborn and refuses to give up even when there is no chance of her coming back. I kept looking for the ref to stop the fight but Lena Gercke kept motioning me to fight. I ended up winning the fight of the night but felt I did so at the expense of Chelsie.



Chelsie Aryn (12-8) vs Gemma Lee Farrell (Centerfold Angels)

Have you ever been so cold that you couldn't stop shivering. That happened to me at UCC X at the last event. Antarctica is the least populated of the 7 continents. The population of the entire frozen hell hole is 4,032 people. Hardly worth having an event there in my humble opinion.

I knew I would have to have a perfect fight seeing that Genevieve was recently promoted to Prospect and would come in with a fresh set of skills.

I made it to the 3rd but the ref felt I was on my way out and stopped the fight. I'll get the opportunity to turn it around in Moscow where I'll be fighting Louisa Rose Allen. Louisa has a similar fighting style so it will be up to me to find a way to get a win. At least I still have strong muscular legs.



Ciara Price (3-1) vs Arianny Celeste (Udder Destruction)

One would think that after watching thousands of professional MMA matches Udder Destructions Arianny Celeste would have picked up a few pointers. Apparently she's more concerned about making sure her tits don't poop out of her top than she is in learning grappling or how to defend against a rear naked choke.

Our fight, if you want to call it a fight, was basically me throwing punches and Arianny doing her best to stop them with her face. I'm not talking like this to be a bitch when you prepare for a fight you expect your opponent to do the same.

After beating Kira Kosarin and Shailene Woodley, the two top ranked Welterweights, on my way to the Welterweight Workout Tournament Title I feel that I can beat anyone.

Adriana Lima would be another stepping stone on my way to a title shot. I expected a good fight from Adriana but wasn't expecting it to arguably become what many consider the greatest fight in UCC history. In fact MMA weekly had our fight as the 2nd best MMA fight of all time comparing it to the Rich Franklin - Stephan Bonnar that catapulted the UFC into the mainstream.

How it ends up in the annals of history is not up to me but I'm glad I got to entertain the fans albeit there were only a few. Unfortunately it was so cold in the arena that the camera froze and our classic fight was not recorded so I'll give you my best account of the insane action.

I hate losing to that slut but it is what it is. This is my 6th loss in my last 7 fights but I will be back and be looking to beat IYFB's Catherine Bell in Moscow.

Middleweights - Esperanza Base - Argentine Research Station (Trinity Peninsula, Antarctica)



Hope Dworaczyk (15-6) vs Chyler Leigh (Raccoon)

Chyler Leigh and her famous pants have been the talk of the UCC. When she gets those pants on she is almost unbeatable. *Kimberly Phillips (10-5) vs **Melissa Sata** (Karate Divas)*

So far in the UCC I managed to get through 14 fights and had success winning 10 of them. My losses were either to submission or ended quickly so I feel fortunate that I have gone through my fights without taking too much damage.

That was the case until I fought Karate Diva Melissa Sata. We fought for a full 25 minutes and when it was over my body was a bruised and battered mess. It was even after 3 rounds but Melissa took over and used her long legs to wear me down.

It was a helpless feeling as the pace was intense and Melisa never let up. I'm not sure what type of cardio training they do over at the Karate Diva's but she never slowed down. I just didn't have anything left and she won the last 2 rounds 10-8. Of course I will recover and be ready for Leigh-Anne Pinnock but hopefully I will be able to beat her quickly and not have to go through another 25 minute war.



Alison Waite (1-0) vs Tiffany Thortoni (Awesome Aries)

I want to thank Kara for giving me a chance to prove that I belong on the UCC. When we were teammates in the UMMA I went behind her back and took over the Badass Bunnies temporarily leaving Kara and Audrey Allen without a stable.

It was an underhanded move which I regret to this day and I apologized to her 1000 times. Luckily for me, Kara is a forgiving person and had forgotten the past. I wanted nothing more than to beat Tiffany Thorton and do whatever I can to prove that I'll be a good teammate.

Amanda Cerny (1-0) vs Loren Gray (Young Guns)

Loren and I are best friends and having to fight her may have caused a rift between us. Having previous experience in the UMMA I tried to warn her not to let emotions take over and win or lose she would have to let it go after the fight was over.

Having been in the cage before I knew I would have a huge advantage. Loren threw 48 punches and kicks and never landed a single one and I could see her frustration grow. She decided to take the fight to the ground and I was unable to stop her as her takedowns are amazing and she was successful in 13 of her 18 attempts.

Loren is very strong and spent most of the fight on top of me throwing down hammerfists and elbows but again my defence was spot on and none of her 89 strikes got through my guard. Loren was furious and kept getting wilder. She wasn't letting me up so I had to find a way to beat her. When I saw an opportunity to wrap my legs around her head I trapped her in a headscissors. Heavyweights - Rothera Research Station - British Survey Base (Adelaide Island, Antarctica)



Valerie van der Graaf (17-5) vs Eugenie Bouchard (Queens of the Cage)

I've been fighting my ass off for the last 6 months and have won 4 in a row and 10 of my last 11. I felt that I could lace up my gloves and hold my own against any Heavyweight. My opponent, Eugenie Bouchard, had also won 4 straight and the only 2 losses in her entire career have been to my teammate Victoria Silvstedt. I knew that this would probably be my biggest challenge to date but liked my chances.

Eugenie must have felt the same way and what started out a close fight slowly started to go in Eugenie's favor. I'm not sure if it was her conditioning or if she just wanted it more but she started getting the better of each exchange. It wasn't like she was dominating the fight but she was winning.

I tried my best and threw everything I had at her but it wasn't meant to be and there wasn't any doubt who would be winning the division. I give her full credit for doing what was needed to win.

I'll get a shot at some redemption in Moscow as we'll have the fight before the main event. I'll go back and look at the tape and see if there is anything I can do and will be ready to give it another go,



Victoria Silvstedt (15-5) vs **Kate Upton** (Death by Bikini)

As much as I hate to admit it, Kate Upton owns me. There I said it. We’ve fought each other 3 times and she has gotten the better of me. The 1st time we fought she ended my 6 fight win streak by closing my left eye in the only the 2nd round. It was the finals in the 1st tournament and a win would have given me a title shot. An armbar from the bottom of guard isn’t something you see everyday but Kate pulled it off and I lost again 1 minute and 12 seconds into the fight. I have the dubious distinction of being the only fighter in the UCC to lose to an opponent 3 times without a win. How embarrassing is that?

I get one more shot at Kate but I’m not sure how to stop her submissions as I am about maxed out as far as my submission defense abilities are concerned. I’ll do my best but until I beat Kate she’ll own my ass. There, I said it again. Kate Upton owns my ass!



Jessica Ashley (10-5) vs Hanna-Maria Seppälä (Raccoon)

With the Centerfold Angels having a very average event I took it upon myself to go out and get a win and hopefully we can build on it for the next event. I got the unenviable task of fighting the strongest fighter in the UCC. OK, that may be my opinion and there are a lot of tough women but through pure power and strength I believe that Hannah-Marie wins hands down.
