This Privacy Policy describes how Migrn ("we," "us," or "the App") handles information when you use our iOS homework planning application. Migrn is a local-first tool for tracking assignment due dates, organizing subjects, and running parent review checklists. By using Migrn, you agree to the practices described in this policy.

1. Overview

Migrn does not require an account, does not operate a social feed, and does not upload your homework data to our servers. All assignment records, photos, voice clips, checklist history, and preferences are stored on your device. We do not sell your data or share it with third parties for advertising or analytics.

2. Information We Collect

Migrn collects only the information you choose to enter or attach while using the App:

- **Assignment data:** titles, subjects, due dates and times, priority levels, notes, and completion status.
- **Subject data:** subject names and display colors you create or edit.
- **Review checklist data:** checklist item labels, check states, custom items, reordering, session timestamps, and parent sign-off notes.
- **Photos:** worksheet images and routine proof snapshots you capture with the camera or select from your photo library.
- **Voice recordings:** short study reminders and parent review notes you record with the microphone.
- **App preferences and usage counters:** consent acceptance, gold coin balance, monthly export counts, unlocked subject slot count, and local in-app purchase fulfillment records used to prevent duplicate coin credits.

Migrn does not collect your name, email address, phone number, location, contacts, or device advertising identifiers. We do not use analytics or tracking SDKs.

3. How We Use Your Information

Information stored in Mign is used solely to provide App functionality:

- Display and organize homework deadlines in the Due Lane and Subject Ledger tabs.
- Attach and play back photos and voice notes on assignments and review items.
- Run daily parent review checklists and save completed sessions to history.
- Generate and save exported subject week card and review report images to your photo library when you request an export.
- Manage optional gold coin balances and apply coin costs when you exceed included allowances (for example, more than three subject week card exports or more than two review report exports in a calendar month, or unlocking subject slots beyond the six included subjects).
- Remember your agreement to the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy on first launch.

We do not use your content for profiling, advertising, or automated decision-making.

4. Device Permissions

Mign requests the following iOS permissions only when you use related features:

Permission	Purpose
Camera	Capture worksheet photos and routine proof snapshots.
Photo Library (Read)	Attach existing images to assignments and review checklist items.
Photo Library (Add)	Save exported subject week card and review report PNG files to your photo library.
Microphone	Record short voice study reminders and parent review notes.

If you deny a permission, Migrn shows a brief in-app notice and does not redirect you to system settings. Features that require the denied permission will not be available until you grant it through iOS Settings.

5. Data Storage

All Migrn data is stored locally on your iPhone:

- **Structured data** (assignments, subjects, reviews, coin balance, export counts, and preferences) is saved in on-device storage (UserDefaults).
- **Photos and audio files** are copied into the App's documents directory under `user_media/photos/` and `user_media/audio/`. Only relative file paths are stored in app records.

We do not maintain cloud backups of your homework content. Migrn retains your information on your device for as long as you keep it in the App or until you delete the App. We do not retain copies on external servers. Exported PNG files saved to your photo library remain under your control until you delete them. If you delete the App or erase your device, locally stored data may be permanently lost unless you have separately backed up your device through iOS or saved exported images to your photo library.

6. Third-Party Sharing

We do not share, sell, rent, or disclose your homework data, photos, voice recordings, or checklist content to any third party.

The only external services involved in App operation are:

- **Apple App Store / StoreKit:** Processes in-app purchases of consumable gold coins. Payment and receipt handling are governed by Apple's terms and privacy practices. Migrn does not receive your payment card details.
- **In-app WebView:** Displays the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy from hosted HTTPS document URLs (Google Docs) when you open those documents inside the App. Only the legal document page is loaded; no personal homework data is transmitted through this view.

Migrn does not integrate third-party analytics, advertising networks, crash-reporting services that collect personal data, or social platforms.

7. In-App Purchases and Local Transaction Records

Migrn offers optional consumable gold coin packs processed through Apple's in-app purchase system. Coin balances and transaction deduplication keys are stored locally on your device to credit purchases reliably and prevent duplicate rewards. These records are not uploaded to our servers. Coins are consumable virtual currency with no cash value and are non-refundable except as required by applicable law or Apple's policies.

Before you use a monthly free export quota, unlock an extra subject slot, or spend coins on an export, Migrn shows a confirmation dialog that states the remaining free uses or the coin cost and your current balance. No coins are deducted without your confirmation.

8. Security

Because your data remains on your device, its security depends primarily on your device protections (passcode, Face ID, Touch ID, or other device security you enable). We do not transmit your homework content over the internet. You are responsible for keeping your device secure and controlling who has physical access to it.

9. Children's Privacy

Migrn is designed for students and parents managing school routines. The App does not knowingly collect personal information from children through online registration because no account is required. All content is entered locally by the device user. Parents and guardians should supervise minor children's use of the App and device permissions. 10. Your Rights and Choices

You control your data through in-app actions:

- **Edit or delete** assignments, subjects, checklist items, photos, and voice recordings at any time.
- **Decline permissions** for camera, microphone, or photo library access; related features will be unavailable.
- **Remove the App** to delete locally stored Migrn data from your device.

- **Export** subject week card or review report images to your photo library when you choose to use the export feature.

Because we do not operate user accounts or remote servers for homework data, we cannot retrieve deleted local data on your behalf.

11. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. When we do, we will revise the "Last Updated" date at the top of this document. Material changes will be made available through the in-app Privacy Policy link and the hosted policy URL shown at first launch. Continued use of Migrn after an update constitutes acceptance of the revised policy.
