Name (Singular and Plural): Goten-Ku

Sexes: Male and Female

Height: Goten-Ku stand at a similar stature to humans, though slightly shorter with their average height range being about 4'10" to 5'10"

Weight: Goten-Ku have a slightly slimmer build than humans, the lower amount of body fat and hollow bones gives them an average adult weight around 90lbs

Hair: Feathered

Skin: Feathered with Keratinized limbs

Eyes: Goten-Ku have three forward facing eyes, Two in standard position and a third on their foreheads.

Ears: None

Appearance and Biology

Goten-Ku are a race of humanoid avians bearing a resemblance to the Tengu of ancient Japanese Myth. They have a largely androgynous appearance, with few details separating the sexes visually. Both sexes lack breasts naturally, though some individuals have been known to add some later through gene mods. All Goten-Ku possess three forward facing eyes, two in the more standard position and a third centered on the forehead. While the paired eyes see similar to most known races, their third eye sees primarily in longer light wavelengths of Ultraviolet and Infrared. Typically this third eye remains closed outside of combat or other specific situations. One of their more obvious physical traits is the presence of a large pair of feathered wings coming out of their back. These wings fold close to their body when not in use, but when extended they have a wingspan well over their body height. These wings are capable of providing sustained flight in most environments, however this is tiring for them to keep

up for more than a few minutes. Their bodies are covered in short feathers with their forearms and legs below the knee are keratinized. Goten-Ku have been observed to have natural feather colors of black, grey, blue, brown, and in rare cases white. After their introduction to the UGC, artificial colors have become popular among the younger generations, widening the possible colors one might find. All members of the species have talons on the ends of all of their digits, which are primarily used as tools to aid in climbing when flight is too tiring, but also make decent natural weapons. Goten-Ku also possess sharp teeth in their beaks as a primarily carnivorous race, which gives them a bite as a natural method of attack. A pair of thick whiskers grow out from near the front end of their beaks. These whiskers can grow up to 6 inches in length, and have been known to be an erogenous zone for both sexes.

Sex and Reproduction

Goten-Ku reproduction is possible without traditional sex, as sperm can be transferred via a cloacal “kiss” just as well as through penetration of the vagina. Goten-Ku are Ovoviviparous, meaning that they carry their eggs internally for a period of approximately seven months, after which they give live birth. Male genitalia is housed inside a genital slit, from which the penis exits during arousal. Males have a degree of control over whether or not their cock emerges, capable of keeping it within it’s genital slit, even when heavily aroused. The structure of their cloaca is similar between males and females when the penis is withdrawn, with soft outer lips and a canal where a partner can penetrate during sex. While females have a gently swirling interior, which results in a soft ribbed feeling, the male’s is a more smooth interior, with their spiralled cock resting in this canal. The female’s vagina possesses no clitoris, however their pussy is quite sensitive, especially the inner walls being littered with nerve endings. Due to the structure of their genitalia, males are capable of having sex as a female would with either male or female partners, however lacking a womb males are incapable of getting pregnant.

Combat

Goten-Ku are typically an adaptable and resourceful people. Their sharp eyesight lends them well to ranged combat, and lighter frames generally lead them to faster and lighter melee weapons such as swords, knives, and spears. While sustained flight for more than a few minutes is rare, they do often use their wings while fighting, giving an advantage when in combat with races who can’t fly, or adding a new variable when in

combat with others who can by changing the field of combat. While fighting races not capable of flight some have been known to use this height to use gravity to assist in hurting their opponents, whether by dive bombing their target, or lifting them into the air before dropping them.

Environments Typically Inhabited

Goten-Ku have been known to adapt well to a large number of environments, including arctic and desert, however many have a particular fondness for much of the environment similar to those of their homeworld, which is primarily covered in mountain forests, jungles, and swamplands. While most tire out quickly while flying, Many prefer to live in places where they are able to stretch their wings and fly, glide, or climb high above the ground.

Society and History

Upon discovery by the UGC, the Goten-Ku were still within a period of feudal warfare on their home planet, various different lords with vassals and territories all vying for power and making alliances. Originally, the UGC had to work with ambassadors from a few dozen different ruling figures, which caused a mass of complications until a more unified governmental body was able to be established a few years after first contact.

Today their society is run largely by feudal lords, who all reside under a ruling figure known as the Emperor, with the lords acting as a representative body for the citizens. Surprisingly, when Goten-Ku colonize and inhabit planets outside of their homeworld, they tend to be largely independent from their Imperial system, with little to no contact with their more unified government, though in most cases they eventually come to join under their Imperial government.

Males and females in their society are almost identical in standing, largely as a result of the lack of physical differences between males and females. As a result they only dictate difference between sex for the means of propagating their species. Typically when mating they make pair bonds, having a single partner a majority of the time. Almost counter to this, casual sexual interaction has been observed in high numbers of their population, so much so that it is considered in their culture to be a common way of building trust and comraderie through friends and companions.
