Treat yourself to a parent night out or get some presents wrapped while we entertain your kiddo! This event will be supervised by BMS 8th graders and parent volunteers.



THEME:

"What Does Service to Your Country Mean To You?"

RULES:

- At the time of the contest, eligible participants must be Students enrolled in one of these four divisions: I-5th grade; II-6th grade; III-7th grade; or IV-8th grade.
- Essay length is not to exceed 300 words.
- Essay must be typed or legibly printed in ink. Also, Essay must be submitted as written (or typed) by the entrant.
- Essay must be submitted for judging to the Elks Lodge nearest to the address of the entrant.
- Participant must be identified by name, grade, school attending and sponsoring Elks Lodge on the Essay.

AWARDS:

The Rhode Island State Elks association awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place for State winning essays in Divisions I, II, III, and IV. Monetary awards will be disbursed for each grade level for 1st Place—\$300; 2nd Place—\$150; and 3rd Place—\$100. Winners will be announced in February, 2026.

ENTRY DATE:

Essay should be submitted to local Elks Lodge on/before December 15, 2025.

The Essay Contest Cover Sheet must be completed for each level of competition and remain attached to the Essay.

The Martin Luther King Day Student Art Contest is still accepting submissions!

The theme of the MLK Day Student Art Contest is "Visions of Soul Force," in keeping with Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s dream that our nation's civil rights movement would continue to resist the dangers of physical violence and oppression with something greater and more powerful... "soul force" (his words). We invite the students of Barrington to help us understand what soul force means through art and creative expression, to be proudly showcased at Barrington's MLK Day event on Saturday, January 17, 2026, at the Barrington Public Library and the Peck Center.

All winners will be recognized at the event.

ART CONTEST

- Concept: Choose one of the options to create a collage/montage illustrating
 what Soul Force looks and feels to you focusing on a set of values, a specific
 time in history, a historical theme related to civil rights history, or a vision for the
 future of civil rights in this country. Your work may include words, photographs,
 fabric, recycled materials, newspaper clippings, images from history, digital
 images, and original creations that can be framed or displayed as onepiece.
- Target Audience: Students in grades K-12 from Barrington schools.
- Submission Requirements: Submissions must be a minimum of 8.5" x 11" and a maximum of 16" x 20". Artwork must include the student's name, school, grade, title, and a short description (15-20 words on the back or on separate paper, explaining how the artwork connects to the theme of Civil Rights or MLK's "I Have a Dream" vision). Artwork must contain no white-space in the background, unless it is a deliberate use of negative space.
- Hard copy submissions will be collected from on Friday, December 12, 2025
- Digital submissions must be emailed to <u>barringtondeicommittee@gmail.com</u> with the subject: Soul Force Art Contest: Student's Name. Include the description as a separate file or within the body of the email.
- **Exhibition Information**: All work will be exhibited and winners announced at "Soul Force: A Celebration of Civil Rights" at the Barrington Library on Saturday, January 17, 2026.
