Name and Contact Section		
☐ Put full name in header		
☐ Make sure first and last name is in big font		
☐ Right below header include address and contact info		
☐ Don't need to include full address only include city, state		
☐ Make sure to include your phone number and email		
Education Section		
☐ Include major, school, GPA, expected graduation date		
☐ Education section can either be right after your name and contact info or can put as the		
last section in your resume		
<ul> <li>Sometimes recruiters might say they don't have a job for a BME major, but if the</li> </ul>		
read all your experiences first they might realize that you are qualified for the job		
even if it isn't traditionally for BME majors		
Work Experience and Extracurriculars		
☐ Use bullets, don't use paragraphs		
☐ Make sure bullets are clear and concise that hook the recruiter		
<ul><li>☐ Start each bullet with an active verb</li><li>☐ Each bullet should fit in one line</li></ul>		
• If the experience is really interesting = 5 bullets		
• If the experience is kind of interesting = 3 bullets		
<ul> <li>Old experience / not interesting = 1 bullet</li> </ul>		
☐ Add numbers/statistics where you can ex. "Improved accuracy of sensor to 90%"		
Formatting		
☐ Clearly divided sections		
<ul> <li>Use bold, italics, indents and uppercase letters to your advantage</li> </ul>		
☐ Consistent format		
<ul> <li>If you list your job title before the location for one experience you must do it for</li> </ul>		
all		
<ul> <li>Make sure indents are the same</li> </ul>		
• Use space wisely		
<ul> <li>Don't have large empty spaces</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Make sure to have enough space between sections that it is easy to read</li> </ul>

Choose experiences wisely to fit each job description

Single line bullets	Too many paragraphs / No bullets
Easy to read formatting	Inconsistent formatting and empty space
Professional and technical skills	Art and headshots
Professional Tone	Hobbies unless they are tied to a skill
