| 07/2025  | Articles & Studies The Name of God — In the New Testament: George Howard, 1978 Evidence that the sacred Hebrew tetragammaton for YHWH was penned in the earliest first Century Greek manuscripts and was dropped later in the second century and replaced with the Greek kyrios and theos. The evidence is that when using the Greek form of words in quoting the Old Testament, there was a blurring of identities as in Psalm 110:1 and Matthew 22:44, etc. It is concluded that "it may be that the removal of the Tetragrammaton contributed significantly to the later Christological and Trinitarian debates which plagued the church of the early Christian centuries."   |

By the turn of the century, Newton's massive "Drafts on the History of the Church" illustrated his views on the Trinity's development, culminating in a rejection of Trinitarian doctrine in favor of "one true God" as the Father alone.  Newton asserted that certain early Church Fathers—particularly the fourth-century Archbishop Athanasius—had deliberately altered the text to align with their doctrinal agendas. Privately, Newton arrived at radical conclusions about the history of Christianity, including a strong conviction that the doctrine of the Trinity was a post-biblical corruption. |

John's father was the 8th in rotation.  Viewing the details of the chart may require zooming to magnify and panning the 14 inch page.   |

| 03/2023 | Evidences section: EXODUS EVIDENCE for 1615 BC, from Geology, Archaeology and Astronomy: The ancient eruption of the volcano in the Aegean Sea named Santorini or Thera has been considered a possible "natural" explanation for the 10 plagues and Exodus has long been postulated. Ash from the eruption is found in both Egypt and Israel excavations. The precision dating of the Thera event that destroyed the Minoan civilization (Crete) has surfaced setting forth a series of eruptions between 1627-1600 BC. Otherwise this is stated as 1613 ± 13 BC. Bible Chronology places the Exodus at 1615 BC, and is central to this projected dating. |
