

Yahoo Kanja-sama!

I have something somewhat..? important to talk to you about today.

I will try to keep it short and precise but I might ramble on. (Future Yume here: This was a lie, Im sorry its 5 pages long) **Warning? Slight immersion break** because I talk about my past teenage years bleh if something sounds weird, I didnt proofread this...

I hinted/talked about it here and there in the past so to some of you this might not be a surprise or something they have to read. I wanted to make a video at first but I cant find it in me to keep my script short, so I apologize for making it a google docky

Either way, I will address this once publicly and then hopefully never again eto bleh

In short, my old branding is hereby void. No more femboy, no more yandere.

First for context, let me tell you how I started out streaming, why I made the decisions I did and what changed, and why I am doing what Im doing now. I first hoped, if I quietly ignore it it will go away but I get a barrage of questions and ough its so embarrassing but basically:

I have been an avid Vtuber fan since Kizuna Ai in 2016, dreaming of doing what she did, but thinking this will never be possible without a shitton of money, I mean after all who could rent out an entire Studio and how expensive are 3D trackers and Models even?! These were things I could only dream of, until 2019 came around, I had taken a 2 year Break from being online, for mental health reasons, I only really used Discord to stay in touch with friends but no Social Media. So when I found out Vtubers were a way bigger thing than they were and L2D was a possibility, I started to dream again. I wanted to become a Vtuber. I was so shy, but I always longed for a community like that, so I went to the drawing board

"How should I design my Vtuber" ??? Well I had multiple Ideas but none really stuck, or felt special So I had the big idea to "just use an Old OC of mine" as a Design, after all they have 100+ artworks already which would make things easier for me to advertise with right?! Hell yeah!

Yume enters the picture: Yume used to be an OC design of mine, which I created in 2015 when I was just a stupid kid. I had subpar drawing abilities and couldnt draw guys, but I desperately wanted a guy OC I could use for BL art and Roleplaying!! (Yes I am that Fujobraind and all my fictional fave characters are guys im sorry)

So what does a kid do in that instance? Draw a girl, say its a guy, ez. I was also super edgy and big into eroguro/gore so I made my oc Yume a Yandere, so I can have an excuse to draw them in gorey situations.

So that was it, right? That was Yumes lore. So when I decided to start streaming with that design, I opted to not do kayfabe, as I am a girl, born a girl, always have been a girl, and it felt like I was a liar if I were to advertise myself as a femboy right? but I cant just change the lore of my OC that has been around for at this point 6 years already !?!? That felt wrong to do too!? So what do I do? Its not like I really care how people refer to me as online either?..

I just dont do Kayfabe! Right? So whenever I had people enter my stream, asking for my lore or pronouns I answered "Well erm Im a girl but erm my Vtuber is a boy duh!" - stupid. Embarrassing. Needlessly complicated. And also lowkey dumb, as It made me go on to give way too sensitive irl information out on stream.

Dont bother looking for that, all VODs have been nuked years ago :P Anyhow.

Time passes, and hey? This streaming thing is starting to feel like its going somewhere, and even more: **My community makes me feel like I have a purpose in life again.** Goals to work towards. Strength I desperately needed in my life, people I felt like I could rely on. I want to do better for them!

I love Idols, I love Vtubers, I want to do Kayfabe! But my Vtuber is a femboy, what do I dooo?! Ok ok. I know. I will just..well. Do kayfabe? I will not tell people Im a girl now, I will present myself like my Oc, right? But my Oc is nothing like me...Im not a guy, Im not tall, Im not sexy or a yandere heck I am a loser virgin, I never had a relationship in my life, who the hell am I kidding how am I supposed to play the role of a lovesick sexy mysterious tall guy??? (Yes 165cm to me is tall, shut up)

So I try to roll with it, although I gave up on the "tall" part quite quickly, too many stories of my irl include me having to climb shelves or getting mistaken for a 12 year old. Whatever, right? I can still pull off all the other things! But heyyy, my old friendgroup was very against Kayfabe, they called my attempts at it cringey, said they wont watch my streams because its "too cringe" so I constantly went back and forth on this Kayfabe thing until 2023 rolls around.

I decided to lock the fuck in.

This debut has been in the years since the start of my streaming journey in 2021, after several delays due to artists scamming and ghosting me, I can finally do it. I can finally commit to it and debut!!

So I do it, I debut as a yandere femboy nurse. I make dick jokes I've seen other femboy vtubers do, because that gives clicks right? (wrong but shh) but oh well. My sweet summer child, little did I know this opened the floodgates for the fetishizers. Dont get me wrong, I have nothing against people who have fetishes, or who do NSFW art/Content, I myself enjoy yaoi and Eroge lol that would be hypocritical of me!! HOWEVER - what I did not know, due to English not being my first language: Femboy is a heavily fetishized term apparently. And I found out the hard way.... So people expected me to be more lewd than I am on stream, I dont mind lewd jokes or Lewd art but I am not a lewdtuber. So the invasive questions about my genitals and the validity of it that followed made me deeply uncomfortable. People swarmed my Maros asking if I "really

had a dick” and to “prove it”, or whenever I made a funny haha suck my dick joke, I got hate maros telling me Im fake anyways bc “we know you have a pussy” :l

It got really annoying and I dreaded committing to my lore and kayfabe, Streaming was supposed to be fun and whimsical, not annoying and filled with people I cant please no matter what I do. Some people even thought I was trans and/or gay, calling me slurs which was really ...yeah..fun... Not to mention my trans audience felt insecure, I got many trans individuals asking me “how I sound so feminine” and how they could achieve the same, which made me feel like a liar, it made me feel horrible because I made some people in my audience feel insecure, I have gotten many people telling me that they wish they could train their voice like “I did” etc - I just felt overall really unhappy with all these circumstances because I always broke kayfabe to reassure people that no no no “im actually a girl” - which - yeah you guessed it... we are right back where I started, the same dilemma again and again.

I also had people hate on me for interacting with my girl friends, because some do GFE and dont interact with guys, so they got hate from their fans too for being my friend publicly, overall it was just doomed to fail, I was never gonna be happy in this predicament.

Not to mention, Yume did not feel like myself. I was not my OC. I was no longer a kid, I since outgrew the cringe lore I wrote back in 2015, why was I trying to hold on to something that has stopped being relevant years ago? Why did I try to preserve this OCs lore when I never used this OC to roleplay that much anyhow? Just cause I got the most pieces of Art for this design compared to my other OCs ?? Whats the point? Whats the point of trying to appeal to friends that wont support you for being cringe, whats the point of catering to an audience that makes you feel uncomfortable, whats the point in not being able to interact with your friends in public, whats the point of being excluded because of your vtuber lore from things etc

Whats the point. Should I just give up and graduate? Try again under a new name, new design?? Or should I try to start over, this time freed from any arbitrary self imposed constrains?

I opted for the later. I did not want to give up what I have built over the years, I did not want to leave Kanja-sama behind, especially those who supported me, the creator behind the design. I want to do better, I want to unapologetically be myself, but in an Idol-kinda way!!!!

So what did I do? I redesigned Yume. First off: No more garterbelts because I also found out way too late that this is a BDSM thing and you can imagine what people expected of me LOL - so begone slutty outfit, and helloooo Moe outfit!! I think its sexier anyways if you leave some things to your imagination, I dont have to show off skin to be sexy, I can do both!! I can be the ultimate cute moe nurse and ALSO be sexy whenever I want, without people looking at my design and expecting me to do lewd things on stream! I changed my reference sheet and outfit to not only be closer to my personal tastes, but also to my irl bodytype. I am flat. I am petite. I am tiny, and I have a babyface, and thats okay!! I dont have to try and be sexy to fit in with my friendgroup !!

I dont have to abandon my Nurse lore - I will still be your nurse, I will still be silly, but I wont be a yandere anymore, I dont want people coming into my streams and ragebaiting me by trying to make me jealous of other streamers, which is also something that happened frequently when I still had that yandere label.

So from here on out: I will abandon these old labels that no longer reflect or fit me. I hope you can understand that change. And while I personally still dont care whatever pronouns you wanna use to refer to me as, I would like to ask you to just stick with female pronouns, to avoid confusion, because thats also something that happened a lot during that phase of me trying to pretend my old shit doesnt exist anymore, people calling me he/him and new people getting confused, which then led me to overexplain everything I just wrote lmao

So yes, I will be silly, I will be myself and I will not do any immersion breaking things anymore, with my vtuber being now really close to my true irl self, this shouldnt be so hard right?

So what changes for you Kanja-sama?

Nothing, just that Im a girl, always have been and going forward will be!!

I will keep my fujo brainrot in the morgue where it belongs ^-^

I still love femboys and the yandere trope (if done right), dont get me wrong!! I especially love my friends who have said lore/trope/label, but I just dont think this is for me anymore and its not something I want to use in my branding going forward.

I will debut my new Model hopefully soon, giving myself a fresh start and do things MY way, no more trying to fit in, no more trying to appeal to people who wouldnt support me anyways, no more bad cringe, only good yuyu cringe going forward !!!

I wanna be a silly moe nurse that rambles on about my delusions and daydreams together with you kanja-sama

Thank you for understanding, this was incredibly hard to write out, and super fucking embarrassing too x-x

I took down any mentions of femboy etc I could in my YT, Clips, Posts, etc I could find, but if you have anything pls tell me and I will delete!! This is also why I wont be restocking any of my old merch, once its gone its gone forever.

Thank you for reading, I just want to close this chapter and go back to being myself again.

I wanted to do this since mid 2024 but always thought I might be too deep into it already, its too late or whatever so I hope i did the right thing

I understand if you no longer want to support me, now knowing about this change publicly, if you

only followed for the bulge, I understand - but thank you for supporting me and giving me a chance and I'm sorry if you feel disappointed or like I'm no longer someone you look up to because I am "just another girl vtuber now"

I still hope I can make a name for myself in my niche, just that this niche is very otaku culture based and I hope I can make you proud with my upcoming debuts (yes multiple planned heh)

I love you so much, thank you for being a rock throughout all of these years for me Kanja-sama. Thank you for sticking by my side while I had my horrible London arc, which is definitely something that helped influence my cringe past decisions... But yeah.

I couldn't have done it without you, I would legit not be here anymore without you. Thank you for keeping me sane. Thank you for loving and supporting me.

I will take this document down soon, and never speak of this again afterwards, this will be the last time I will address all of this!! Thank you for understanding

And to my friends, Thank you for your support too, I love you so much, Thank you for giving me the courage I needed to write this down.
