HERO Program (9th-12th) Complete application by Sept 18th

HERO, which stands for Health Exploration Resources and Opportunities, is a no-cost 1-to-1 online mentoring program that pairs high school students with volunteer medical students trained in mentoring and STEM education. HERO is a unique opportunity for interested students to explore health career exploration tools, human anatomy and physiology, disease etiology, and community health topics. These sessions are scheduled by the participant and mentor once per week, from October to December, at a time that works best for their schedules. The program aims to enhance science achievement and postsecondary pathway planning for Vermont teens in 9th through 12th grade living in Caledonia, Essex, Franklin, Grand Isle, Lamoille, Orleans, Orange, Washington, and Chittenden Counties. Participation in the program is limited and selection is based on demonstrated interest in health and medicine and ability to commit to the full duration of the program. Rosie's Girls for grades 5-8 and non conforming youth in partnership with Vermont Works for Women at the MS Art Room A173 begins 9/23 ends 11/4

Rosie's Girls® is a trades and career exploration program for 5th graders and middle school girls*. Through hands-on learning and a research-based social/emotional curriculum called Power Skills, Rosie's Girls helps youth break down gender stereotypes, develop self-confidence and build connections. Last year Winooski RG participants created a cornhole set and giant dice for the MS school! New projects could include storage benches, cubbies or folding beach chairs. This class focuses on the Persistence GX in the area of Math Reasoning. *Rosie's Girls welcomes anyone who identifies as a girl regardless of assignment at birth, as well as youth who are non-binary or gender expansive who are comfortable in a girl-centered space.
